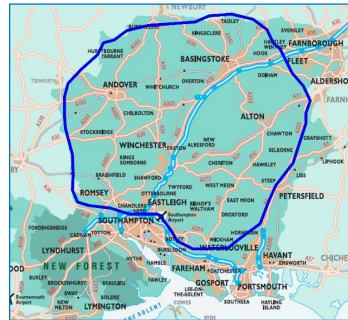
What is happening & why?

- Integrating BNHFT & WEHCT
- Acquisition process because have to ensure future as a foundation trust (FT)
- Why are we doing this:
 - To **retain** local services for local people
 - To **develop** local services for local people

Two Trusts – Stronger Together

Vision for integrated organisation

- One service across 2 acute hospitals
- Delivering services as close to peoples' homes as possible
 - 3 hospitals (BNH, RHCH, AWMH)
 - Community hospitals
 - GP surgeries
 - Locality facilities



Two Trusts – Stronger Together

Process to date

- Due diligence complete
- Planning phase underway
 - Aiming for end Sept 2011
 - Generate business case & integration plan
- Transaction Autumn 2011
- Integration early 2012

Two Trusts – Stronger Together

Stakeholders and roles

- HOSC
 - Significant services issues
 - Reflecting public views
 - Influencing service model
- PCT/GPCCs
 - Commission services
 - Influence service model
 - GPs influence/exercise choice for patients
 - Transitional funding
- SHA
 - Vendor
 - Manage dissolution for SoS
- Cooperation & Competition Panel
 - Assess economic benefit
 - Assess impact on choice for patients and GPs as referrers
- Monitor
 - Assess business case
 - Provide risk rating
