1. The decision:

- a) That the revised Development Scheme for the preparation of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan be approved with effect from 7 September 2011.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. Hampshire County Council is a minerals and waste planning authority and has a statutory duty to prepare and maintain a minerals and waste development scheme as required by the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.
- 2.2. The legal compliance of the Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan will be scrutinised by an independent Planning Inspector on, amongst other criteria, whether the Plan has been prepared in accordance with the minerals and waste development scheme (as required by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004).

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. The County Council could decide not to up-date the development scheme and rely on informal communication. Although this method has previously proved effective (the scheme was advertised on the County Council website) it was considered appropriate to formally update the scheme as most key milestones have now been identified.
