

## Falls and Falls Prevention

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## Background

*In March 2011 the Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee Falls Review provided NHS Hampshire & Hampshire County Council with four recommendations.*

1. Health and social care to work together to develop an integrated falls and bone health strategy
2. Up-date existing service specifications and care pathways
3. Identification of appropriate data and information to ensure effective evidence based commissioning and improved sharing of activity data
4. Define measures of success for integrated working

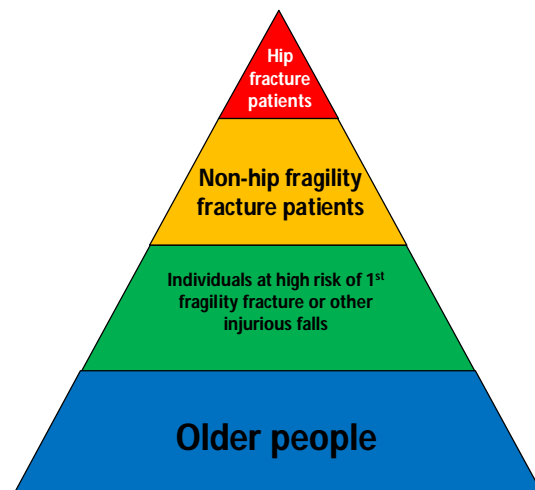


## Overview

## Our approach



Tier 4: Improve outcomes and improve efficiency of care after hip fractures

Tier 3: Respond to the first fracture, prevent the second

Tier 2: Early intervention to restore independence

Tier 1: Prevent frailty, preserve bone health, reduce accidents

## Key actions

- Adult Joint Strategic Board established Task and Finish Group
- Task and Finish Group
  - Began to identify local needs and data requirements (Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA) & Director of Public Health Annual Report) using DoH Falls and Fractures JSNA template
  - Workshop with providers
  - Developed draft strategy
  - Started to work on revised pathway and specs
- Enhancement of Tier 1 community based falls prevention services
