1.1 That the Executive Member for Communities and International Relations approves a sum of £10,707 to be awarded to Lymington and Pennington Town Council to purchase a disabled pool lift and playground equipment for disabled children, via the Hampshire Action Team for New Forest, for 2010/11 only, with no expectation of funding for future years.

2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1 With regard to the pool lift, it will assist disabled people to enjoy swimming at the Lymington Sea Water Baths, thus tackling social inequity in the area.
