**1. The decision:**

1.1. That the Executive Member for Communities and International Relations approves a sum of £2,496 to be awarded to Peace of Mind Care to run a DVD project and confidence- building courses for young people, via the Hampshire Action Team for Basingstoke and Deane, for 2010/11 only, with no expectation of funding for future years.

**2. Reason(s) for the decision:**

2.1 The project will be for a drama coach for 3 hours per week to run workshops on confidence building, loss and separation and bullying to work with school aged children giving them the opportunity to express their feelings in different ways.

2.2 The project will also work with 3 groups of 20 young people aged 8-16 years from the Basingstoke & Deane area working on a DVD type project based on issues relating to young people i.e. bullying, crime, alcohol/drug abuse, teenage pregnancy where they can write scripts, design sets and design costumes.

2.3 These activities will encourage young people to be creative, think about issues that are important to them and how to resolve them, encourage confidence building, increase self esteem, and team building.
