To approve for submission to the Leader and Cabinet:

- 1.1. The proposals for savings totalling £16.3m, which together with the full year impact of 2011/12 savings of £4.9m meet the 8% target of £21.2m set for Adult Services in 2012/13 (as set out in Appendix 1 and 2).
- 1.2. The annual review of income and charges (as set out in Appendix 3).
- 1.3. The revised budget for 2011/12 (as set out in Appendix 4).
- 1.4. The summary budget for 2012/13 (as set out in Appendix 4).
- 1.5. The workforce implications of the proposed budget for 2012/13 (as set out in Appendix 5).

- 2.1. Cabinet has requested that service budgets be prepared within the budget guidelines confirmed by Cabinet for approval by Executive Members and submitted to the Leader and Cabinet for consideration in February 2012. Proposals need to be submitted to the Cabinet on 3 February 2012 in order to influence decisions on the 2012/13 budget.
