## **1. Executive Summary**

- 1.1. A total budget of £3.25m for 2011-12 was confirmed by Hampshire County Council on 24 February 2011, to support the provision of Short Breaks for Disabled Children within the framework of The Breaks for Carers of Disabled Children Regulations 2010.
- 1.2. The purpose of this paper is to seek the approval of the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services for grants to be allocated over the value of £5,000, totalling £55,287 to Voluntary Sector and other organisations in Hampshire.
- 1.3. Grants awarded to organisations in this report will enable them to continue to develop and provide services for disabled children and young people, which contribute to the range of services required to be provided within the framework of The Breaks for Carers of Disabled Children Regulations 2010.
- 1.4. In addition to the above Grant awards, a total of £79,605 has been awarded between April and October 2011 to support individual disabled children and young people to access mainstream leisure and recreation activities where specific individual provision is required to ensure their full participation. These Grants are all under £5,000 and allocated by officers under delegated powers.
- 1.5. A Grants programme for April 2012 – March 2014 is currently underway with further Grants Panels held in December 2011. The Decision Report detailing recommendations from these panels will be considered by the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services at a separate Decision Day, in February 2012, date to be confirmed.

## **2. Contextual information**

- 2.1. The Regulations bring into effect Paragraph 6(1)(c) of Schedule 2 to the Children Act 1989 (inserted by section 25 of the Children and Young Persons Act 2008), requiring local authorities to provide services to assist individuals who provide care for disabled children to continue to do so, or to do so more effectively, by giving them breaks from caring.
- 2.2. The Regulations state that “a child is disabled if he is blind, deaf or dumb or suffers from mental disorder of any kind or is substantially and permanently handicapped by illness, injury or congenital deformity or such other disability as may be prescribed”.
- 2.3. The Regulations also define short breaks with the caveat that provision shall be made, in so far as is reasonable and practicable, for a range of services which are sufficient to assist carers to continue to provide care or to do so more effectively. In particular the local authority must provide, as appropriate, a range of:
- day-time care in the homes of disabled children or elsewhere;
  - overnight care in the homes of disabled children or elsewhere;
  - educational or leisure activities for disabled children outside their homes;
  - services available to assist carers in the evenings, at weekends and during the school holidays.
- 2.4 Parents and carers of disabled children have contributed to the design and proposed delivery of the services for which grant funding has been applied for through feedback and consultation with service providers, through formal and informal evaluation of existing provision, and through participation in local Groups.
- 2.5 The process adopted for the evaluation and allocation of grants has been broadly consistent with that of the Children’s Services Integrated (CSI) grant process in order to ensure a consistent approach to grant provision across Children’s Services. The panel for this particular round of evaluation and allocation comprised a variety of HCC officers from the Short Breaks team, other HCC colleagues who work with us on the Short Breaks programme, two parent representatives and a representative from Parent Voice.

## **3. Grants for Approval**

The following schedule of grants are recommended to the Executive Member for approval. The grants are awarded following the evaluation of bids received from providers following an advert requesting a range provision from across the county, in order to provide additional services for the remainder of this current financial year (a table summarising the following grants has been included as Appendix C).

- **All of Hampshire**

**SPACE Short Breaks**

Funding to provide a new service of short breaks into the child's own home for up to 4 hours at a time. SPACE Carers (also known as Community Childminders) can offer parents the opportunity for their child to be in a familiar environment while they take a break. The National Childminding Association will co-ordinate the scheme.

The Panel has recommended a total of £9,959.

- **Andover / Test Valley**

**Andover Leisure Centre, Andover**

Funding for two Caring For You open days; to have tasters of a wide variety of sports and art activities, where families all attend together. Funding for a 10 week multi activity club at the leisure centre for children with disabilities and their siblings.

The Panel recommends a total of £10,998.

- **New Forest**

**First Opportunities, Ashley**

Funding for twice-weekly specialist play sessions for under-3s at a specialist pre-school providing a high level of support.

The Panel recommends a total of £5,686.75

**UK Youth - Avon Tyrell Outdoors Centre, Bransgore**

Funding for three different service provisions:

- Funding for activities for February Adventure/Cycling weekend.
- Funding for daily Funday activities during February half-term week.
- Funding for supporting a specialist Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme, which will meet fortnightly and support young people with disabilities to achieve the award.

(The Activity Centre's funded Short Breaks are open to anyone in Hampshire).

The Panel recommends a total of £16,800

**The Gap Club**

Funding to support children to attend the after-school club and holiday clubs at Gap Club. This includes where higher staff ratios and 1:1 is

needed due to the disabilities/support needs of the children. (Previously funding applications have been made for individual children).

The Panel recommends a total of £11,843

#### **4. Future Direction**

- 4.1. We have commenced the commissioning and procurement process for grants to be allocated for the financial year 2012/13 considerably earlier this year to ensure organisations are provided with more planning time.
- 4.2. It is also expected that, dependent on the success and service user feedback of this year's and next year's schemes, we may be in a position to award grants for longer than one year for some services in the future, providing more stability and development opportunities for organisations.
- 4.3. The participation and engagement of parents and carers and children and young people will also be enhanced in the planning and development of future Short Break services by the continued development of the Parent Forum (and also by the required consultation exercise as future service statements are prepared).

#### **5. Finance**

- 5.1. The grants referred to in this report are proposed from the allocation of £3.25m to support 1200 children and young people accessing local universal services. Grants of under £5,000 will continue to be awarded by officers under delegated powers following this report; with the grant funding remaining of this allocation. For your information, Appendix D gives details of smaller grants of under £5,000 awarded to organisations, from April 2011 up to the end of October 2011. These services offer provision of:

- educational or leisure activities for disabled children outside their homes;
- services available to assist carers in the evenings, weekends and school holidays.

- 5.2. This funding has also been used to provide in-house services in the following two areas:

- **All of Hampshire**

- **Adoption Support Services**

Funding to provide a range of short breaks (individual child and whole family activities) targeted specifically at newly adopted children with disabilities and/or additional needs; running throughout 2011. Further monitoring of the services provided will be completed.

The funding awarded is a total of £15,000.

- **Fareham & Gosport**

**Haven Children's Centre, Gosport**

Funding to develop short break service provision at the specialist SEN hub for under-8s and their families has been agreed; including Stay and Play at weekends; Friday fun evening for children with autism; and fortnightly drop-in activities sessions (weekly in the school holidays).

The funding provided is £24,300

**6. Recommendation**

6.1. That the Executive Lead Member approves those Grant applications over £5,000, totalling £55,287 to the organisations listed in section 3 above; and also notes the funding allocations in section 5 above.
