1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to recommend that the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services makes an appointment to the Hampshire (Schools) Admission Forum, in accordance with his responsibility set out in Part Two of the County Council's Constitution.

2. The Hampshire (Schools) Admission Forum

2.1. The Hampshire Admission Forum considers a wide range of admissions issues and plays a major part in reviewing and advising on admission arrangements.

2.2. The County Council may appoint between one and five representatives on the Admission Forum. For several years representation was provided by Councillor Allgood and by Councillor Mrs Bailey. The death of Councillor Allgood in the autumn of 2011 has led to the consideration of the appointment of a new representative.

2.3. Councillor David Drew has expressed his willingness to become a member of the Admission Forum, representing the County Council.

2.4. The spokesperson from the opposition on Children's Services matters, Councillor Jackie Porter, has been consulted on the potential appointment of Councillor Drew.

3. Recommendation

3.1. That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services appoints Councillor David Drew as the second Hampshire County Council representative on the Hampshire Admission Forum, to serve alongside Cllr Mrs Bailey, until the Executive Member for Children's Services Decision Day following the annual meeting of the County Council in 2013.
