1. Executive Summary

1.1. The purpose of this paper is to recommend that the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services makes an appointment to the Bramshott Educational Trust, in accordance with his responsibility set out in Part Two of the County Council's Constitution.

2. The Bramshott Educational Trust

2.1. The Bramshott Educational Trust, is a fund to support young people under 25 years of age in the Bramshott Parish. The Parish includes Liphook, Bramshott, Passfield, Conford and the parts of Hammer Vale located in Hampshire.

2.2. The Trustees meet twice yearly and award grants supporting educational activities which in the past have included help towards purchase of musical instruments, educational travel, specialist tools and sports equipment for individuals, and outreach groups and local schools for extra curricular activities.

2.3. The Trust's terms of reference require that one of the five Trustees shall be nominated to the position by Hampshire County Council as the local education authority. The position has become vacant following the death of Councillor Sam James.

2.4. Councillor Ferris Cowper, the local Member has proposed East Hampshire District Councillor Angela Glass be considered for the role as she lives in Bramshott and has strong links with the County Council. Councillor Glass has indicated her willingness to accept the position, if appointed.

2.5. The spokesperson from the opposition on Children's Services matters, Councillor Jackie Porter, has been consulted on the potential appointment of Councillor Glass.

3. Recommendation

- 3.1. That the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services appoints Councillor Angela Glass as the Hampshire County Council representative on the Bramshott Educational Trust, until the Executive Member for Children's Services Decision Day following the annual meeting of the County Council in 2013.
