1. The decision:

Subject to the approval of the 2012/13 budget by County Council, the Executive Lead Member for Children's Services:

- a) Approves the Children's Services Integrated (CSI) grant applications over £5,000 for 2012/13, totalling £1,019,948 for organisations within Hampshire as listed in Appendix 3, noting amendments.
- b) Approves the Youth Support Services grant applications, totalling £1,654,909 for organisations within Hampshire as listed in Appendix 5, noting correction.
- c) Endorses the CSI grants awarded to organisations in December 2011 as listed in Appendix 6.
- d) Approves the £10,000 allocation to Rock Challenge.
- e) Further to the decision of the Executive Member for Culture and Recreation (20 January 2012, reference 3096), accepts the budget transfer of £21,100 being a grant awarded to the Prince's Trust for youth participation and employment activities in 2012/13.

The Executive Lead Member for Children's Services also agrees an additional award to the 2011/12 grant to the Prince's Trust of £7,500 from Children's Services (Adult Learning) budget.

- f) Asks that officers explore the possibility of developing further partnership services with these grant streams with the support of additional resources, should they be identified.

2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. These decisions support the following Hampshire County Council priorities;

“Making Hampshire safer and secure for all” – by supporting organisations that provide positive activities for children and young people.

“Maximising well-being” – by supporting organisations that deliver services to children and young people, or aim to help vulnerable children and young people.

2.2. They also support the outcomes of the Hampshire Children and Young People Plan (CYPP), the Local Children’s Partnership priorities and all the five outcomes of Every Child Matters.

2.3. The YSS decisions will support the provision of local projects and services which have been steered by the Local Children's Partnerships in line with the government’s commitment to the 'Big Society'. These services retain a focus on young people who are the most vulnerable enabling them to access targeted services in their local area.
