- a) That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport approve the proposed 'StreetSense' toolkit for enhancement of road safety for 11 – 16 year olds in Hampshire for implementation in 2012/13.

- 2.1. To address the accident pattern within Hampshire involving 11 to 16 year old children and to promote a safer environment and enhance quality of place for residents.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. The proposed programme contains a range of options as part of an overarching toolkit of possible solutions. Alternative approaches were considered in terms of a more focussed programme at Secondary Schools involving direct engineering solutions, however it was preferred to form the basis of the programme around changing behaviour, as this is seen as the key factor in engaging with 11 to 18 year olds.
