1. The decision:

1.1. In considering the grant requests, it was noted that the sum available for allocation was £194,965. It was therefore agreed to make the following decisions on the grant requests received:

- a. Hawley Scout Group- £4,691
- b. North Baddesley Youth and Community Club- £2,000
- c. Brendoncare Club Hampshire- £4,500
- d. UK Youth- Avon Tyrrell- That the organisation be asked to explore its own reserves for the upgrades required
- e. Gosport Borough Council- £5,000
- f. The Medusa Trust- £4,580

1.2 A sum of up to £25,000 to be set aside from the Policy and Resources Capital Programme towards commissioning a commemorative bronze disc showing the Queen's head in profile, as part of the Diamond Jubilee celebrations.
