- c. Farnborough Air Sciences Trust- £10,000

- f. Viable Community Association, Basingstoke- Defer for further information regarding organisation's reserves
- g. Royal British Legion Farnborough Corps of Drums- £4,000
- h. 7th Bramshill Hook Scout Group- £2,000
- i. Laverstoke Park Education Centre, Overton- £1,700
