- a) That the Youth Support Service (YSS) grant applications totalling £26,665 for organisations within Hampshire be approved.
- b) That the Additional YSS grant applications totalling £89,133 for organisations within Hampshire be approved.

- 2.1. These decisions support the following Hampshire County Council priorities;
