**THE HAMPSHIRE (HART DISTRICT NO. 69)
(PARISH OF ODIHAM - PARTS OF FOOTPATH Nos. 18, 22, 23 AND 25)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2006**

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the public it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted;

G. H. Janaway & Sons Limited has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new sites of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

The Hart District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Odiham and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this Order and described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up when Hampshire County Council has certified that the work necessary to bring the sites of the new footpaths, specified in paragraph 3 below, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.
3. There shall be at the end of 56 days from the date of confirmation of this Order public footpaths over the land situated at Odiham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the map contained in this Order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITES OF EXISTING PATHS

Odiham Footpath No. 18

From GR SU 473656 152450 (point C) to 473696 152242 (Point E)

That part of Odiham Footpath No. 18 which commences at its junction with Odiham Footpath No. 23 (point C on the accompanying map) and proceeds in a southerly direction along a concrete track between farm buildings to a point just north of a ramp leading to the bridge over the A287 road (point E).

A total length of 214 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 22

From GR SU 474394 152104 (point H) to 473832 152144 (point G)

That part of Odiham Footpath No. 22 which commences at Point H and proceeds in a west-northwesterly direction across an arable field to a point in the middle of the field and then runs south-westwards to the field headland at Point G.

A total length of 644 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 23

From GR SU 473416 152326 (point A) via 473598 152452 (point B) then via 473656 152450 (point C) to 473672 152450 (point D)

That part of Odiham Footpath No. 23 which commences at a stile beside a road bridge over the River Whitewater and proceeds north-eastwards along a narrow concrete access road to the centre of a vehicle marshalling yard and then east to a shallow bend in the way at a point where Footpath No. 23 emerges into open fields to the south.

A total length of 300 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 25

From GR SU 473574 152492 (point F) to 473598 152452 (point B)

That part of Odiham Footpath No. 25 which commences at the north-western edge of a vehicle marshalling yard area and then runs south-eastwards to its junction with Odiham Footpath No. 23

A total length of 45 metres.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITES OF NEW PATHS

Odiham Footpath No. 18

From GR SU 473672 152450 (point D) to 473696 152242 (point E)

From its junction with Odiham Footpath No. 23 (point D) proceeding generally south along a headland footpath, 2.0 metres wide, to rejoin Odiham Footpath No. 18 at a point just north of the ramp leading to the bridge over the A287 road (point E).

A total length of 208 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 22

From GR SU 474394 152104 (point H) via 474356 151988 (point K) to 473832 152144 (point G)

From Point H, proceeding south-southwest along a 2.0 metre wide footpath along the western side of a fence to meet the field boundary north of the A287 road at Point K and then west-northwest along a 2.0 metre wide headland footpath to rejoin Odiham Footpath No. 22 at Point G.

A total length of 664 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 23

From GR SU 473416 152326 (Point A) via 473360 152360 (Point L) to 473538 152550 (Point J)

A footpath 2 metres wide which commences at a stile beside a road bridge over the River Whitewater on the northern side of the A287 and proceeds west-northwest for 25 metres along an access road, then through a gap and down an inclined ramp bordered by fences to a kissing gate (point L) in the field corner, then runs north-eastwards along a headland footpath, 2.0 metres wide, on the western margins of the water meadow, to a further kissing gate (point J) on the fence line north of the River Whitewater at a junction with Odiham Footpath No. 25.

A total length of 333 metres.

Odiham Footpath No. 25

From GR SU 473574 152492 (Point F) to 473672 152450 (Point D)

From point F at the north-west corner of a vehicle marshalling yard a footpath 2 metres wide which runs south-eastwards along a grass verge and a tarmac footpath on the northern edge of the yard, and then east to its junction with the existing section of Odiham Footpath No. 23.

A total length of 128 metres.

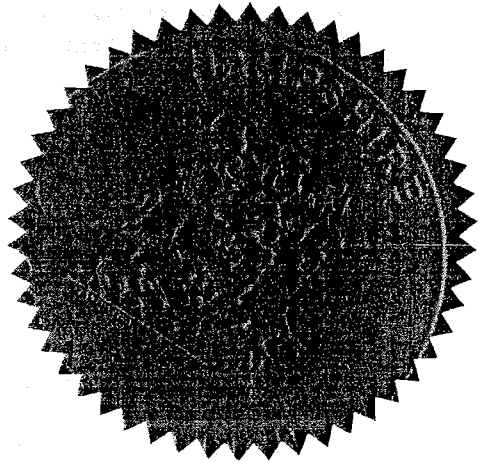

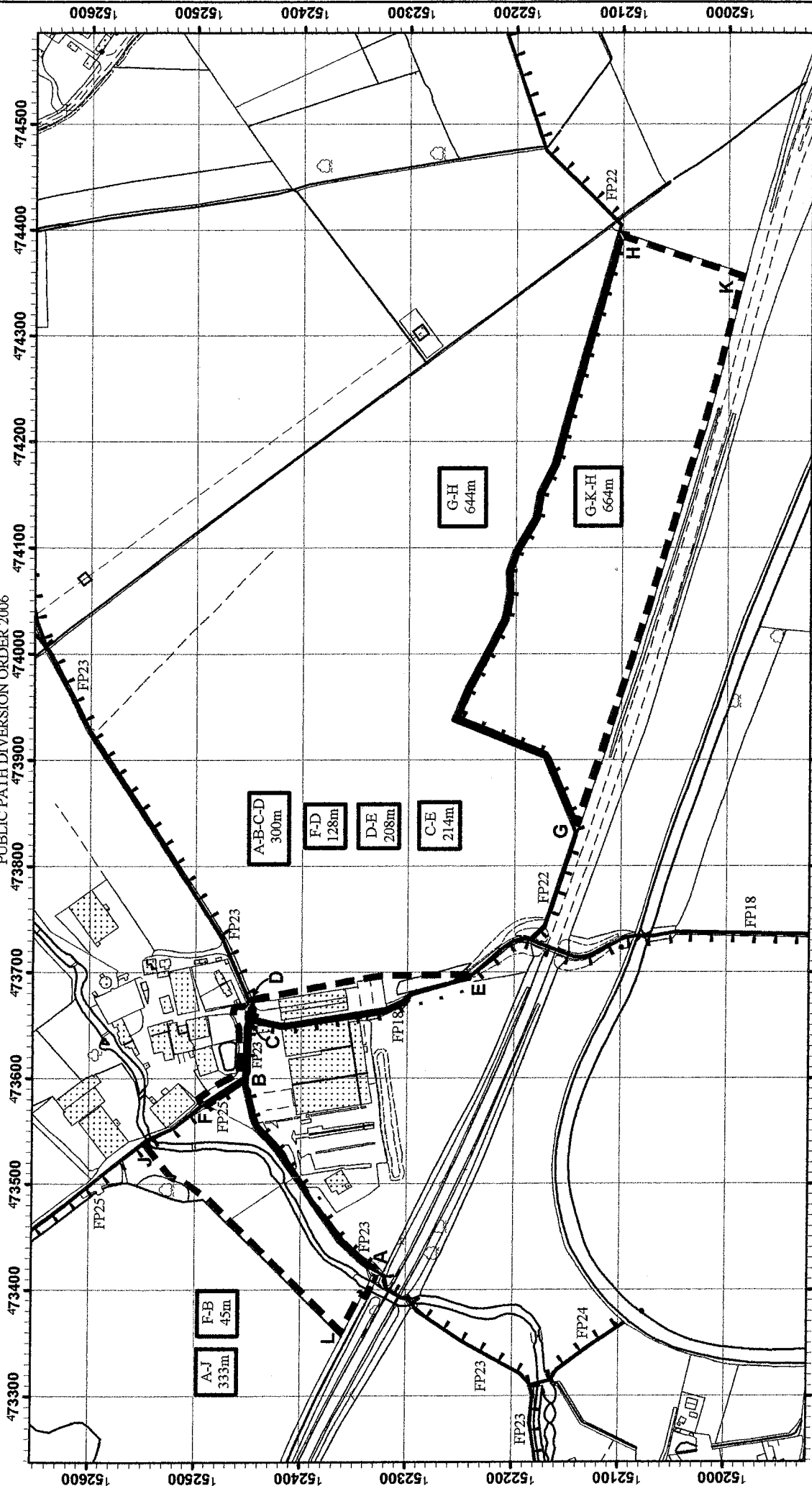
