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#### 1. The decision:

- a) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care approves for a Single Tender for contracted older people's day care from August/September 2012, depending on individual contracts, to 30 June 2013 at a value of £2,348,888.
- b) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care grant permission to go out to tender for older people's day care on a 1 year + 1 year + 1 year basis to a total maximum contract value of up to £2,285,793 per annum for three years, with a maximum total value of up to £6,167,287.
- c) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care endorses the overall direction of travel set out in this report which promotes personalisation for the individual, enhances the approach to prevention and re-ablement across services and aims to strengthen local communities.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. These decisions support the departments commitment to delivering services to older people in a way that is more responsive to their needs and supports the departments vision around early intervention , prevention and re-ablement.
- 2.2. These decisions will also enable and support communities to become more dementia friendly and inclusive of older people enabling them to live the lives they want for longer and at home with fewer interventions.
- 2.3. Current data shows that day services are under utilised and not a service of choice in their existing format for many older people. Resources currently directed to day services exceed demand ,this action will ensure that these resources can be redirected more effectively in the future.
- 2.4. Market development will be encouraged and growth will be seen in more personalised and diverse range of services

3.1. Day services remain in their current format with the focus being on dementia care and meeting high support needs only .

3.2. Selection of one organisation to modernise day services across Hampshire.
