1.1. To consider the following recommendation reported to the Buildings, Land and Procurement Panel on 3 July 2012:

- a) That the project proposals relating to the relocation and expansion of Tweseldown Infant School to provide a 270 place three form entry (3FE) infant school on the proposed new housing development on the former Queen Elizabeth Barracks site in Church Crookham, Fleet, as well as the refurbishment works to the vacated infant school building to enable the expansion of Church Crookham Junior School to 4FE, at an estimated total cost of £5,500,000, be approved.
