1. The decision:

- a) That authorisation be granted to advertise the proposed Traffic Regulation Order on Naishes Lane, Church Crookham.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The local member for Church Crookham, Councillor Radley, has withheld her consent for a Prohibition of Driving Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to be advertised which is required in order to deliver a package of Section 278 highway works on Naishes Lane, Church Crookham, as agreed at the planning application stage. It is considered that there are sound reasons for the Order to proceed and therefore authority is sought from the Executive Member for Environment, Transport & Economy to allow the Order to be advertised.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. To not proceed with the TRO. This would prevent the highway improvements coming forward in their current format which are required to accommodate traffic associated with a major residential development in the area. The existing layout is not suitable to manage the additional traffic volumes and would result in an unacceptable impact on the highway were the improvements not implemented. This would also potentially delay the delivery of the wider development site.
