Progress Update

- Access and Assessment teams were rolled out in April
- Phased transition of Community Treatment Teams is now complete
- Hospital at Home services available in all areas, and final phase will be completed in the North at the end of the summer
- Continuing to develop the Intensive Support Programmes across the region
- Recruitment to Acute Transfer Facilitators will be completed in September
- Remaining bed closures will have taken place by 1st August

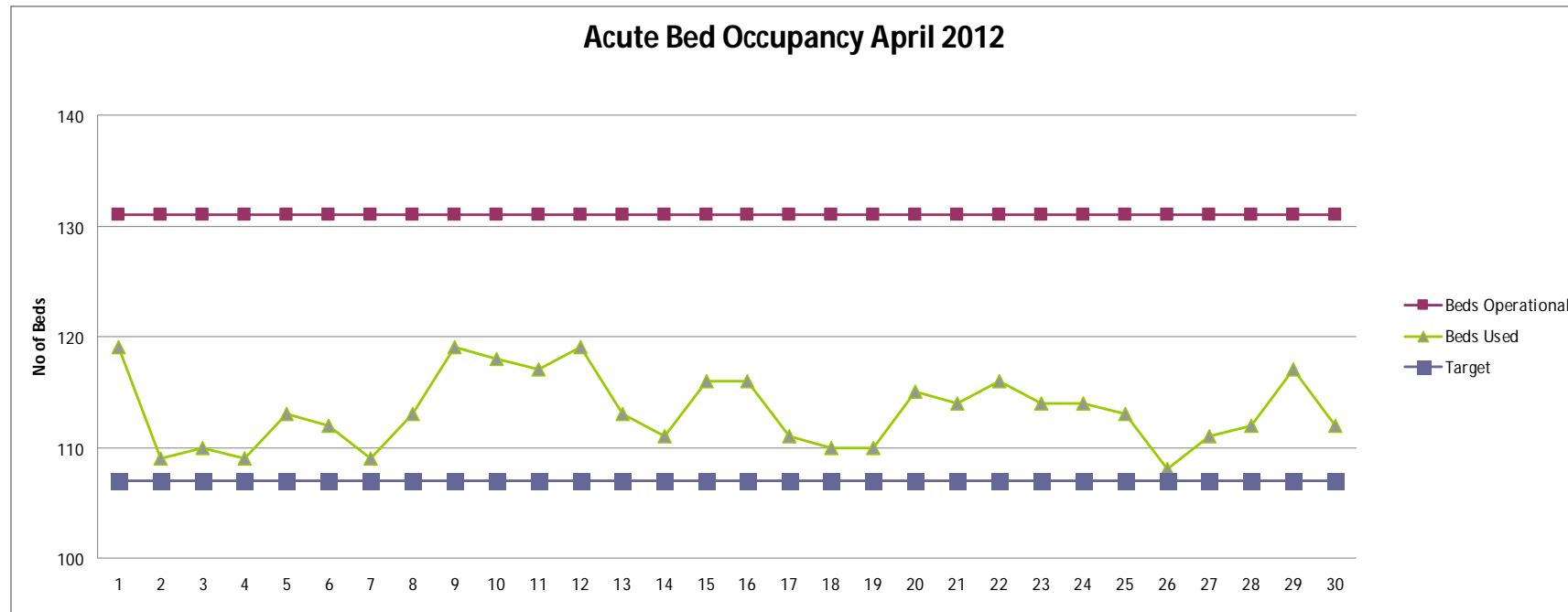


Progress Update

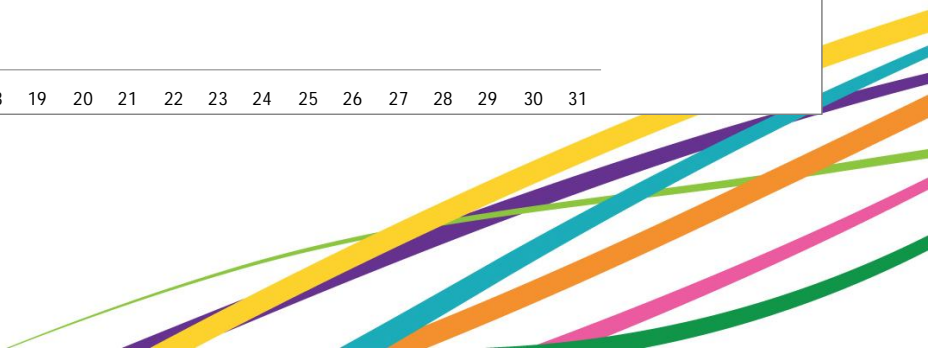
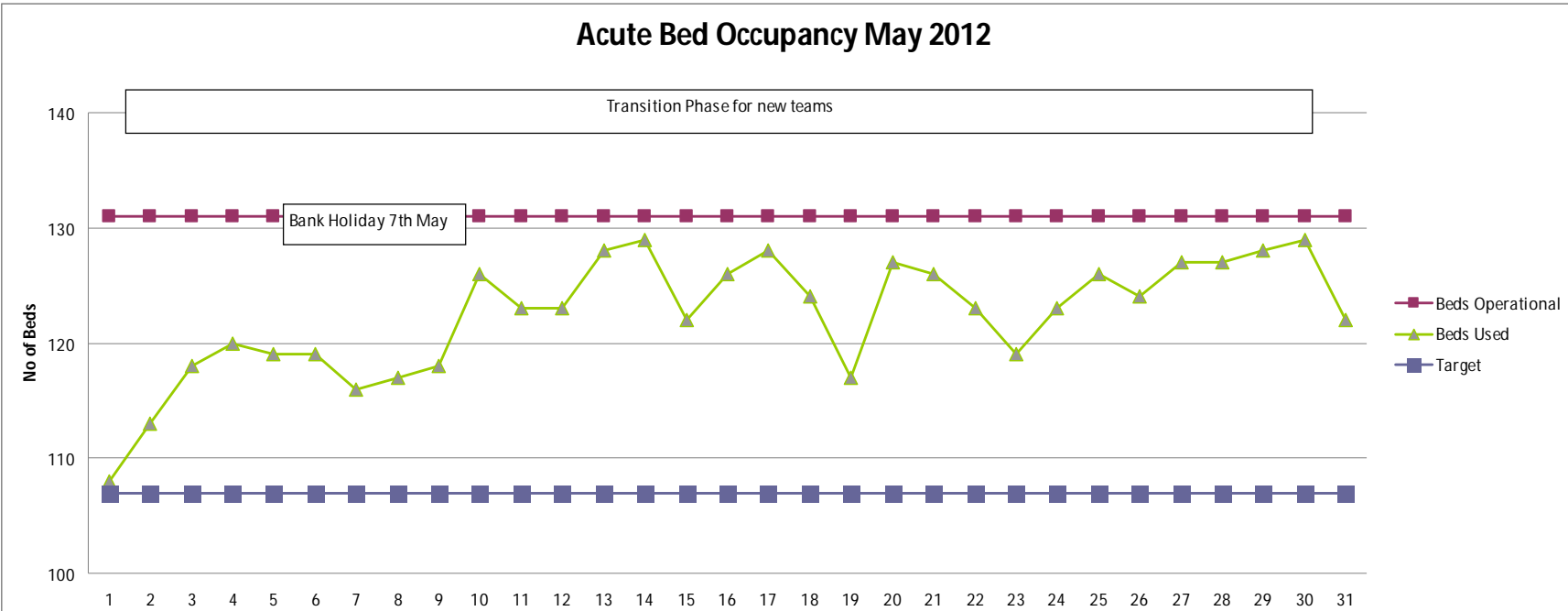

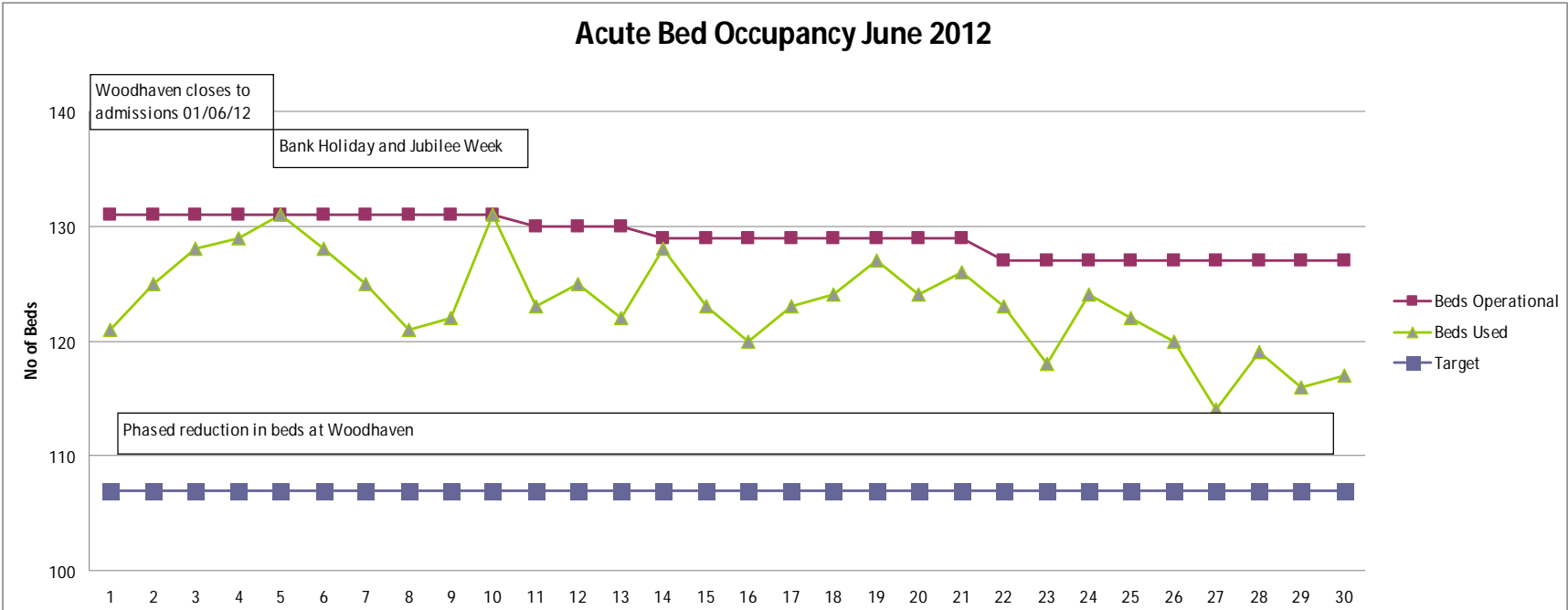
Bed Usage



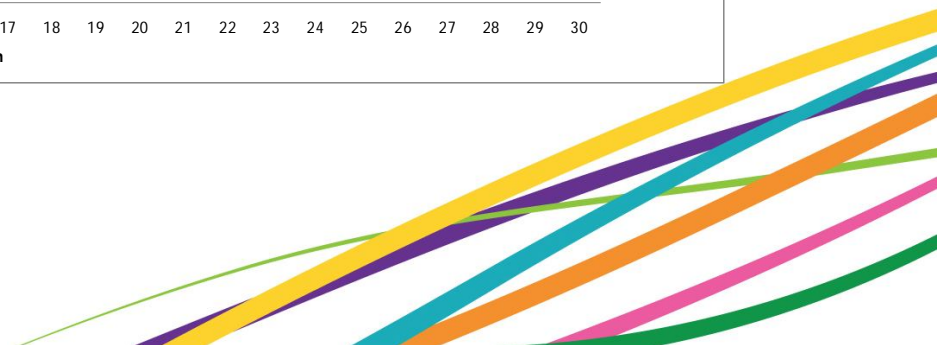
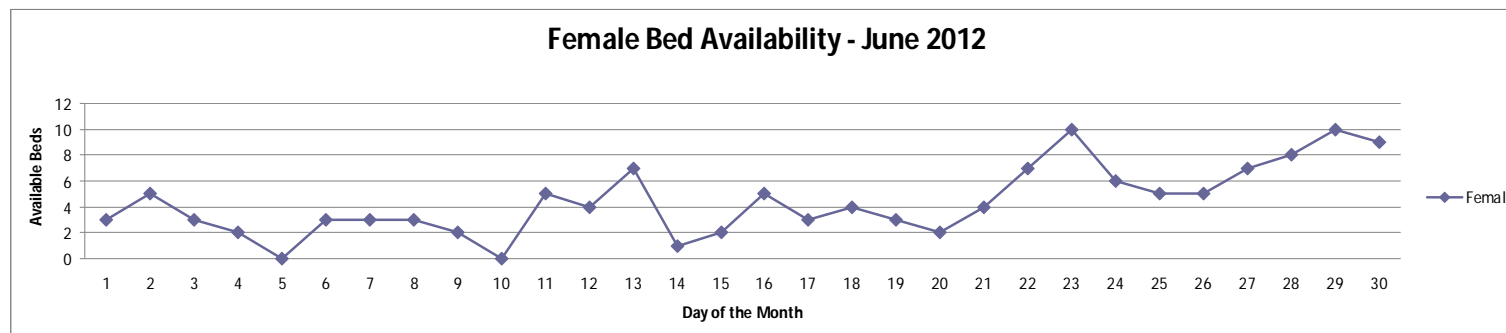
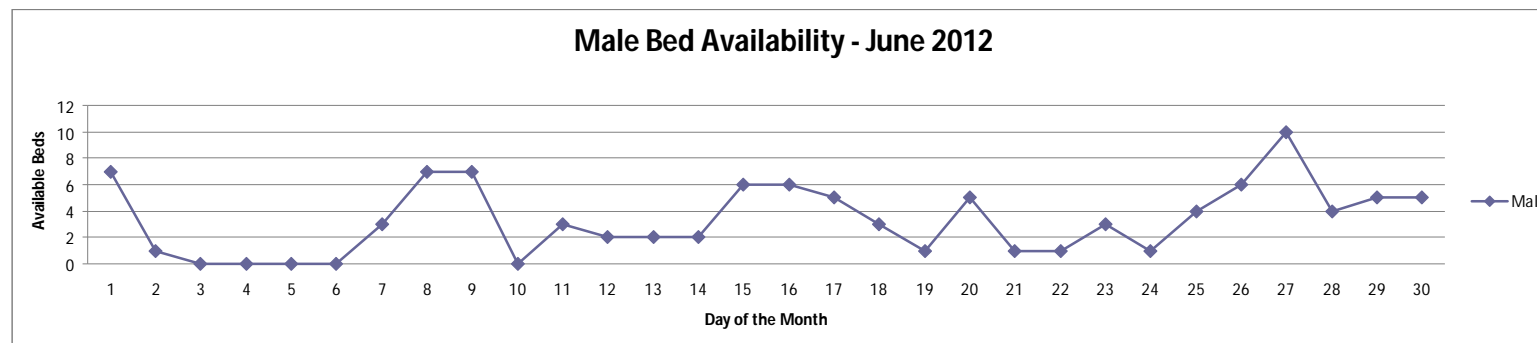
Bed Usage
