**1. Summary**

1.1 Following the endorsement by SACRE at the meeting held on 19 June 2012 regarding the co-option of a representative from an academy, Mrs Gill Heron, the Head of Religious Education at Thornden School, Chandlers Ford, has been invited to join SACRE to represent an academy voice.

1.2 Following the retirement of Julie Lemon, the co-opted member who represented special schools, it is proposed that Miss Ceri Taylor from Maple Ridge School, be appointed as her replacement.

1.3 Co-opted members are not members of any of the four main groups of SACRE and do not have voting rights. They are, however, able to participate fully in discussions at SACRE meetings.

2.1. That SACRE confirms the co-option of Mrs Gill Heron to represent an academy on SACRE.

2.2. That SACRE approves the co-option of Miss Ceri Taylor to represent special schools
