1. The decision:

- (a) That approval be given to award a contract under the Dynamic Purchasing System, as set out in 5.1 and 5.2 of this report, to provide an opportunity for a Community Transport Service to be established in Hartley Wintney and become viable and financially sustainable by the end of the contract period.
- (b) That the resulting contract will be of up to 7 years duration with a maximum value of £246,000, all of which relates to Hampshire County Council.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. To improve transport services through the introduction of a Community Transport Service in Hartley Wintney. The service will be introduced using developer contributions from the Dilly Lane development following a survey of local needs completed by the parish council. The transport services provided by the Community Transport Service will help to contribute towards the County Council's well being agenda by providing people with opportunities to access local services and facilities.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. Providing a conventional bus service was rejected following consultation with Hartley Wintney Parish Council. It was felt that a Community Transport option, using an accessible minibus, would better serve the needs of the local community. The developer also supports spending the money on a Community Transport service.
- 3.2. The award of a single tender contract for the Community Transport Service was considered. This was rejected on the grounds that an expression of

interest was received from one other party with regard to providing some of the service which the Community Transport service would be expected to provide.
