1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Policy and Resources be notified that land at 2 North Cross Street is now surplus to Highways, Traffic and Transport requirement, and that disposal of the property should therefore be considered.
- 1.2. That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport recommends that any Capital receipts received as a consequence of the disposal of this property (which was purchased from Highway funding) be reserved for the development of future plans of the BRT project.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The property at 2 North Cross Street, Gosport was purchased by Hampshire County Council in 2002 in connection with the Fareham – Gosport Light Rapid Transit (LRT) scheme, which has now been superseded by the Bus Rapid Transport (BRT) Scheme. As a consequence the property is now no longer required by the Economy, Transport and Environment Department and should be considered for disposal as it is a maintenance liability to the department. The BRT scheme has a number of further phases yet to be programmed, and as funding is a significant constraint, the capital receipt for the sale will be considered as a contribution to help secure further Government funding for BRT.
