

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')**

#### **REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS**

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. It sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which includes giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Executive Member for Adult Social Care intends to take a key decision on *Confirmation of the Supporting People County Core Group decision to spend in relation to social exclusion* at a meeting on Tuesday 19 March 2013 at 15:30 at The Castle, Winchester.

The report seeks the approval of the Executive Member for Adult Social Care for authority to spend from the Supporting People budget up to a maximum of £10,727,956.19 pa and 5 year aggregated value of £53,639,780.96 to allow contracts identified and commissioned through the Supporting People Strategic Review process to be issued from 1 April 2013.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Executive Member's intention to take this key decision due to the analysis of the total figures, which need to be confirmed through standard governance processes in advance of any spending.
