1. The decision:

- a) That the Whitehill & Bordon Walking and Cycling Strategy, Parking Strategy, Traffic Management Strategy and Public Transport Strategy be approved and adopted by Hampshire County Council under the Emerging Transport Strategy for Whitehill & Bordon (September 2011).

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1 To provide a clear and up to date statement of current transport policy and strategy for the regeneration of Whitehill & Bordon following the conclusion of a number of studies. This helps to support the corporate strategy in proactively planning for the re-generation of Whitehill & Bordon to ensure that it is developed and enhanced in a manner which does not detrimentally impact on the quality of life of the existing and wider communities.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1 **Do Nothing** – This option was considered but discounted on the basis that, as identified in the Emerging Transport Strategy, clear guidance is required on the transport strategy for the regeneration of Whitehill & Bordon to ensure that adequate transport infrastructure is delivered alongside the planned development and growth. The four transport strategies provide that guidance, and provide a baseline of information for the development of future planning applications for the land.
