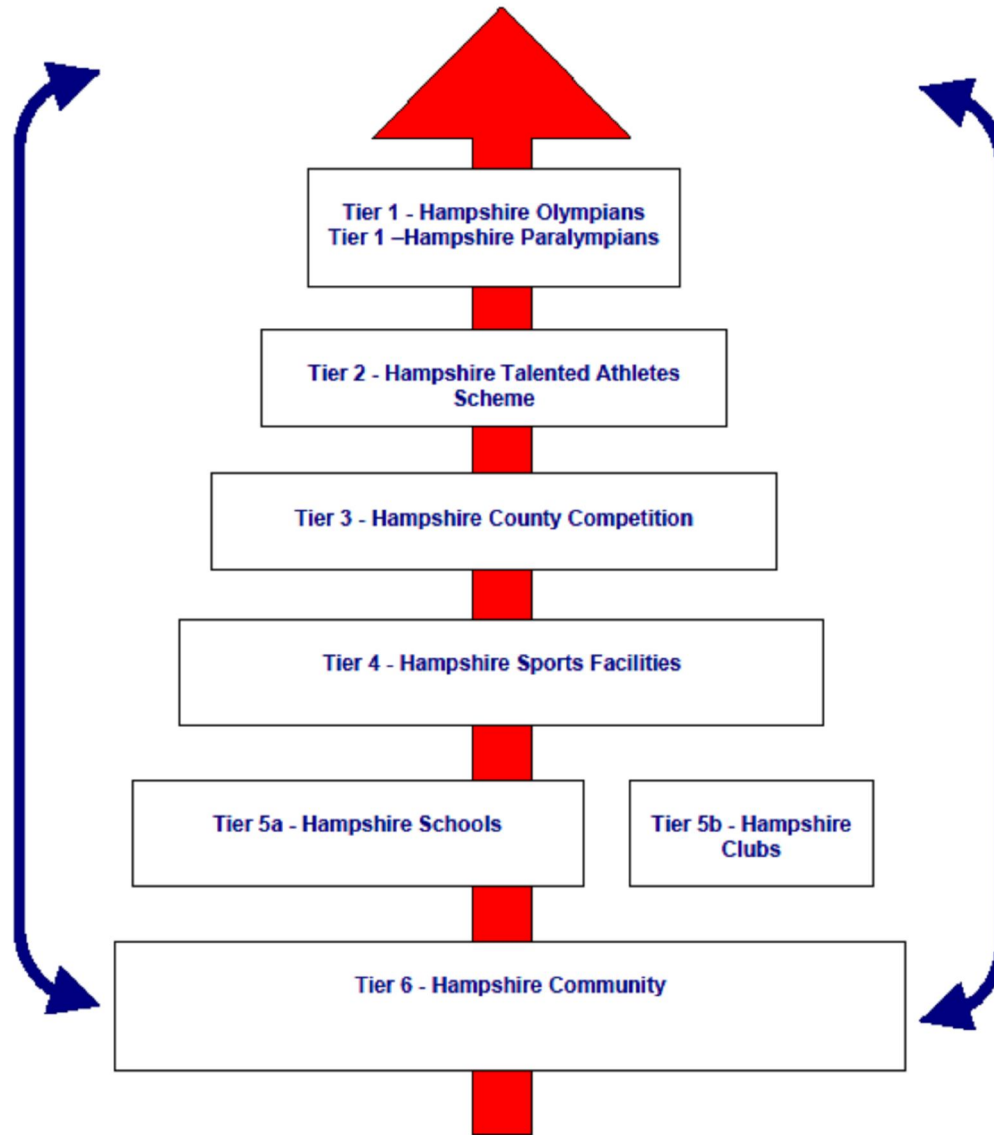

Legacy for Schools 1

- Develop a 'Culture of physical activity' in primary schools in particular.
- Olympic/Paralympic values as core school values – Engage with the Get Set Network
- Using sport to raise attainment
- Develop the 'Be inspired for life' resource

Legacy for schools 2

- Use sport to engage NEETs
- Use sport to support members of 'Troubled Families'
- Use Olympians/Paralympians as positive role models
- £150 million of Government Olympic funding for primary schools, £9,000 per school

Paralympic legacy for schools

- Development of sporting opportunities for children with disability especially through the School Games
- Development of clubs offering Paralympic sport
- We now have Solent Sharks wheelchair rugby, Goal ball at Peter Symonds college and plans to extend wheelchair racing from 1 to 3 centres in Hampshire

Sporting competition for our children

- How we organise & fund the Hampshire Games
- Directing the work of the School Games Organisers
- Support for the voluntary but well established School Sports Associations

- Assist clubs access funding & use of quality sports facilities
- Assist with improving school/club links
- Increase the volunteer base & recruit more coaches
- Increase access to the 'Sportivate' funding stream
- Work with clubs to attain accredited 'Club Mark' standard

Hampshire Community 1

- Construct a county events calendar showing all physical activity opportunities
- Link with national opportunities such as Ride London
- Promote opportunities through the world events being staged in the UK during this 'Golden Decade
- Form a volunteer events team of Hampshire London 2012 Games Makers for county events

Hampshire Community 2

- Develop more physical activity opportunities at our Country Parks
- The development and promotion of Hampshire Legacy events

 2. 'Lepe into Action'
 3. The Saucony Hampshire Athletics Grands Prix

Hampshire County Council

- Integrate work with the Public Health team on projects related to increased physical activity within local communities
- Develop HCC Health and Wellbeing Strategy to increase the number of opportunities for staff across the county to engage in workplace activities
- Work across HCC to develop a Cycling Strategy for the County Council
