1 Introduction

- 1.1 The Children's Services Department will inform the Panel regarding the progress made by schools in the Eastern half of the county in special measures, having a notice to improve, serious weaknesses or below Government floor standards.
- 1.2 A list of the schools is attached as Appendix 1.
- 1.3 Ofsted's Section 5 reports and Section 8 monitoring reports are attached as Appendix 2 for the convenience of members.
- 1.4 For reference, the confidential minute from the last time that the Panel discussed schools in Eastern Hampshire is attached as Appendix 3.
- 1.5 A confidential oral update on the schools listed in Appendix 1 will be provided as Appendix 4.

2. Background information on overall Ofsted outcomes

- 2.1 A new Ofsted framework was introduced in September 2012. The new framework is certainly robust and rigorous. However, the impact on outcomes for schools in Hampshire has generally been positive. Out of the 103 schools in Hampshire inspected during the autumn term 2012 and spring term 2013:
 - 95 schools (92%) at least held their previous overall effectiveness judgement
 - 51 schools (50%) improved at least one grade
 - 8 schools (8%) dropped a grade, 4 of these went into a category.

2.2 When the overall picture across the county is considered, an encouraging pattern can be seen. The proportion of outstanding schools is holding; the proportion of schools judged to be good is increasing; and the proportion of satisfactory/requires improvement (RI) schools declining. In addition, the slight increase in schools judged inadequate has begun to decline and is now in line with national figures.

Schools in the Eastern Area of Hampshire below the Government's floor standards based upon 2012 outcomes.

The coalition Government has set floor standards for both primary and secondary schools and has asked Local Authorities to take a robust stance towards those schools below floor to secure rapid improvement.

A primary school is deemed to be below the floor standard if less than 60% of pupils attain Level 4 in both English and mathematics **and** where progress is less than the national median in both English **and** mathematics. The national medians are currently 92% of pupils making two levels of progress in English and 90% of pupils making two levels of progress in mathematics.

A secondary school is deemed to be below the floor standard if less than 40% of pupils attain 5A*-C including English and mathematics **and** where progress is less than the national median in both English **and** mathematics. The national medians are currently 70% of pupils making three levels of progress in English and 70% of pupils making three levels of progress in mathematics.
