19. CRESCENT PRIMARY SCHOOL, EASTLEIGH

1. On the 25 June 2013, the Executive Member for Policy and Resources approved designs for the £5.6million expansion of Crescent Primary School (off Toyndee Road, Eastleigh), to create a three form entry school providing an extra 210 places and cater for a total of 630 pupils. Subject to planning permission, work is expected to start in December 2013 and finish in October 2014.

2. The project includes the development of nine new classrooms and the replacement of two temporary ones. Other improvements will take place to the existing teaching spaces, a new main hall, entrance, reception, toilets and staff accommodation, improved play area and the relocation of the habitat area.

20. NIGHTINGALE PRIMARY SCHOOL, EASTLEIGH

- a. On the 25 June 2013, the Executive Member for Policy and Resources approved designs for the £950,000 expansion of Nightingale Primary School to create an additional 105 places, so that the school could accommodate a total of 420 pupils.
- b. The work includes two new reception classrooms, toilet facilities, play area, entrance, reception, main office and classroom conversion.
- c. Subject to planning permission, it is anticipated that work would commence in December 2013 and conclude in August 2014.

21. THE WESTGATE SCHOOL, WINCHESTER

- a. On the 25 June 2013, the Executive Member for Policy and Resources approved the project proposals for the provision of primary school places at The Westgate School, Winchester at an estimated cost of £7.75million. The project is part of the County Council's £15million investment in primary school places in Winchester to meet future demand of local school places.
- b. The work will provide extra school places to cater for pupils aged from 4 to 16 years old, in the first through school of its kind in the county. Primary age pupils will be provided with facilities including 14 new classrooms, a

library and ICT area, play areas, food tech and specialist practical areas, as well as facilities for teachers and staff, office spaces and toilet, plant and kitchen facilities. In addition to a music and drama room, also available for community use, a main hall will be provided which will be able to be used as a dining hall, performance space, gymnasium and assembly hall. The nursery provision at the school will be combined and relocated to a new purpose built building with direct access to new outside play areas. Additional car parking will also be provided on the school site along with extra parent drop off facilities on the nearby Chilbolton Avenue.
