22. SINGLE TENDER APPROVAL FOR OLDER PERSON'S DAY SERVICES AND PERMISSION FOR A COMPETITIVE TENDER FOR OLDER PERSON'S DAY SERVICES

1. On 28 June 2013, the Executive Member for Adult Social Care approved contracts for externally provided day services for older people

2. Older person's day services provide a range of daytime activities and support to enable individuals to continue to live in their own home or with their family or carer. The services aim to provide access to activities, care and support that enable individuals to remain resilient in the community. Additionally, the services aim to enable people to live longer in their own homes and to increase the amount of time that people spend in a state of independence and good health.

23. PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES AT PROPOSED OAK PARK HEALTH AND WELLBEING CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT

1. On 28 June 2013, the Executive Member for Adult Social Care approved proposals to go out to tender for the procurement of services on the Oak Park Health and Wellbeing Campus. The procurement will enable the provision of a 24/7 on site care and support service within an Extra-Care assisted living scheme for older people, as well as the option for Hampshire County Council to purchase up to 10 re-ablement beds within the nursing home.

2. The County Council is committed to working with the NHS to provide nursing and re-ablement beds at a health and wellbeing campus on the combined land at Oak Park, that would also include an Extra-Care housing development. Both of these proposed developments will provide much needed additional capacity to meet the growing needs in the area.
