Summary of Decision:	To note and endorse the progress and future direction of the Supporting Troubled Families programme.
Reason for decision being taken in private:	The appendix to the report is not for publication as it contains exempt information within Paragraph 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 12 A to the Local Government Act 1972, being information which is likely to reveal the identity of an individual. Further, it is considered that, in all the circumstances, the public interest in maintaining this exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing this information. While there may be a public interest in disclosing this information, namely outlining the
