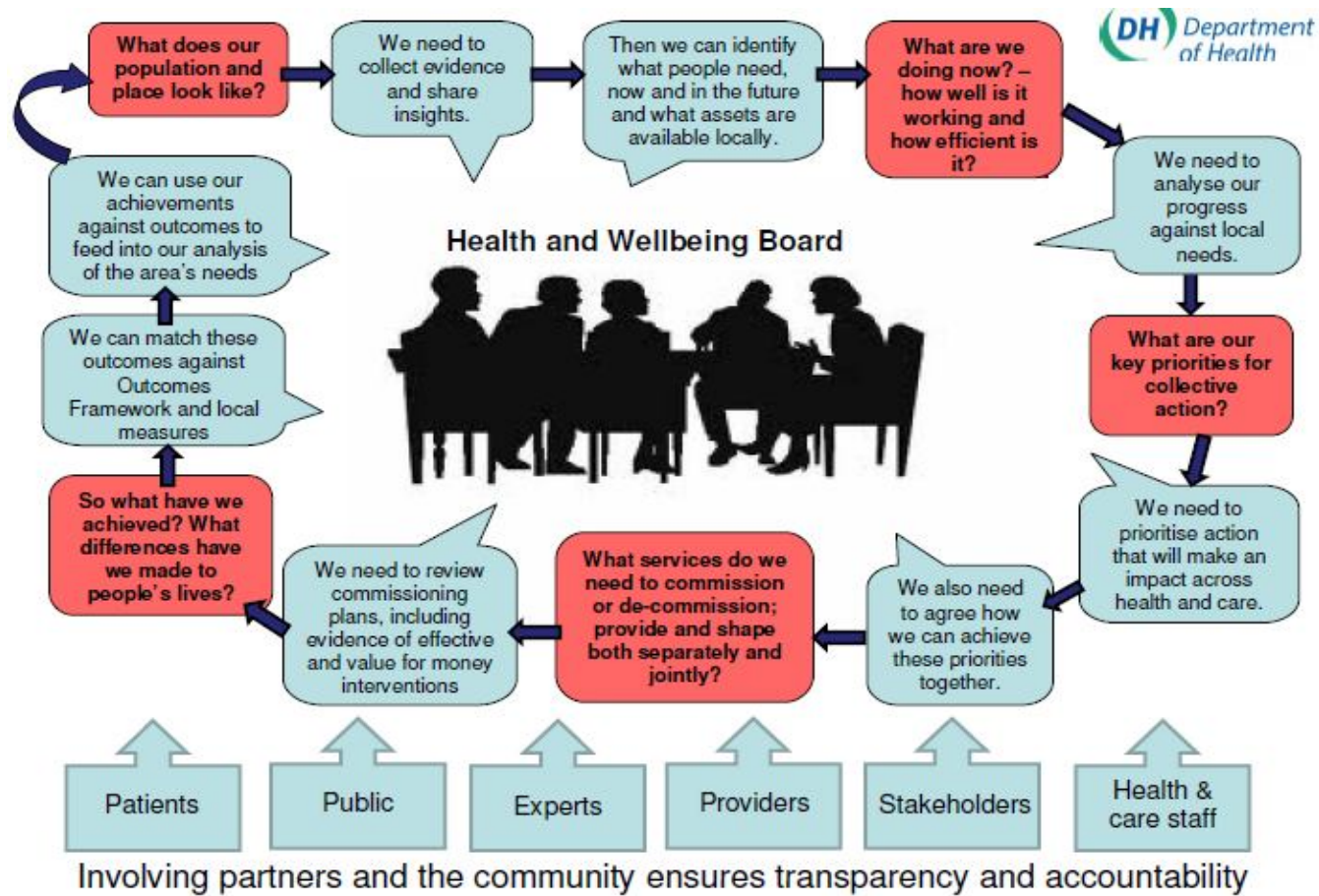

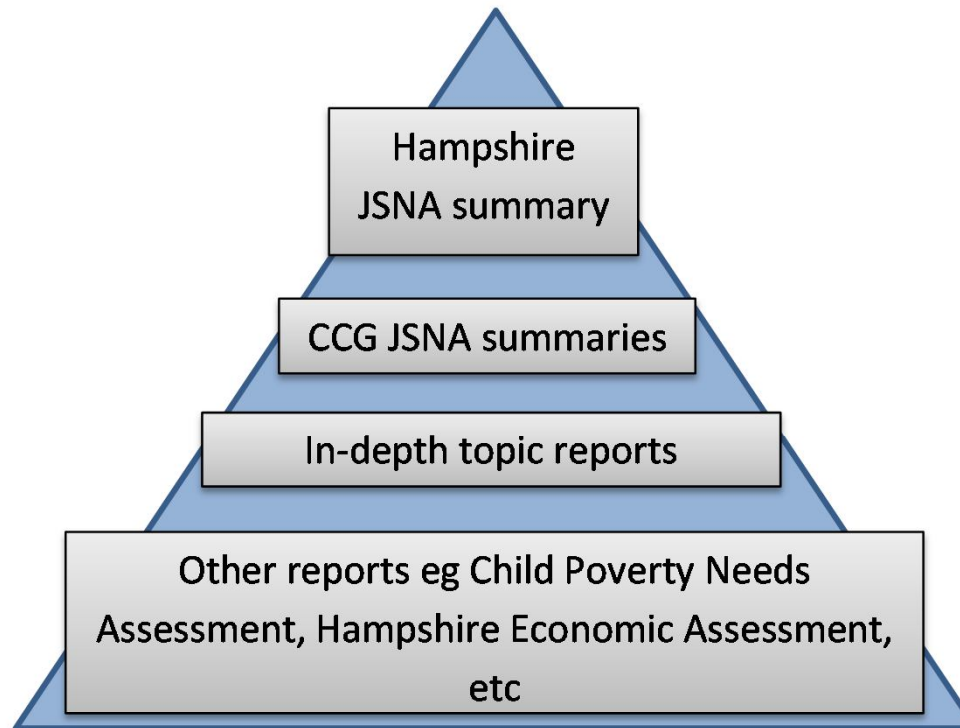

Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA)

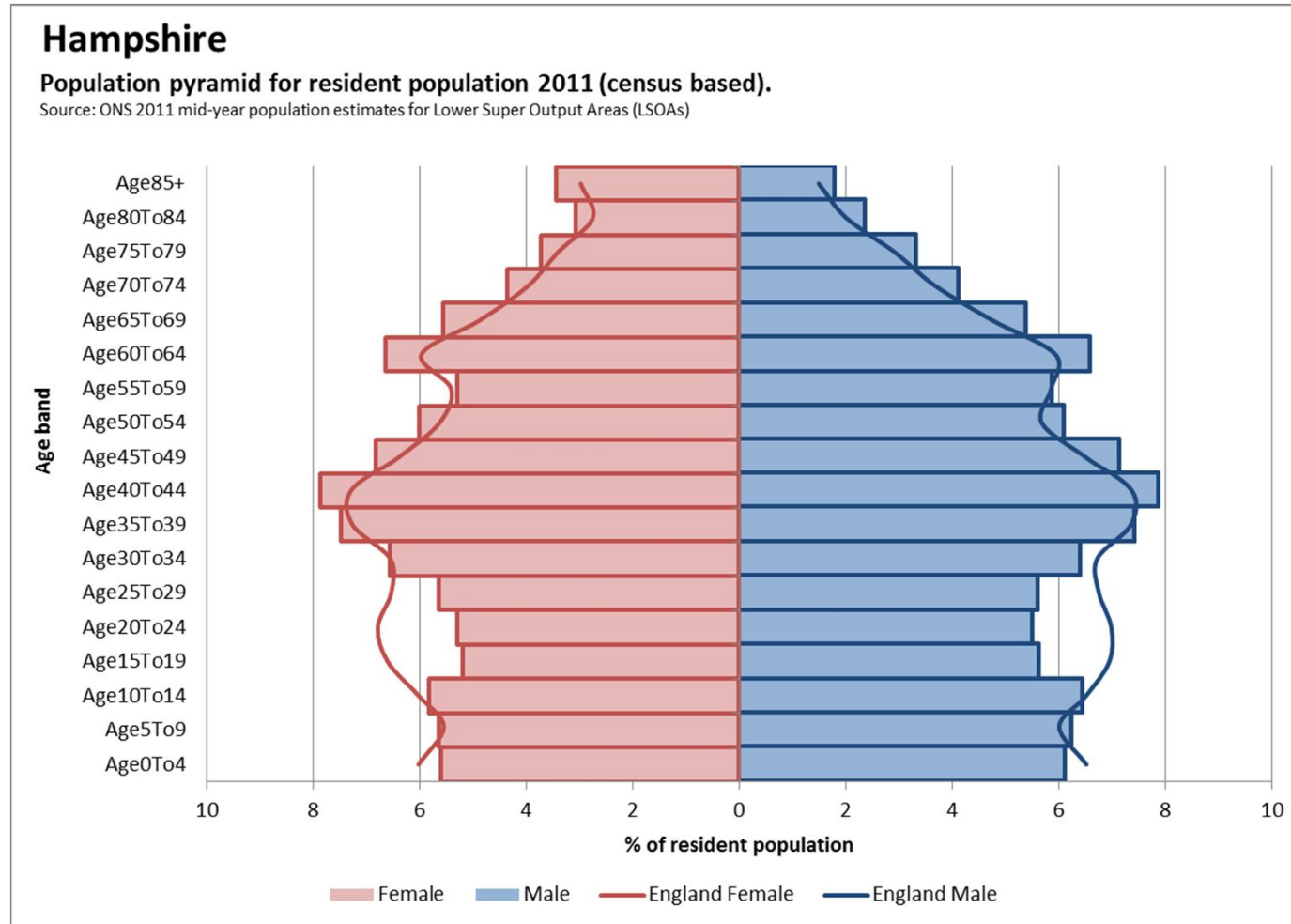
- The vehicle for HWB to give a comprehensive picture of local health & wellbeing needs

- Present data in an accessible format



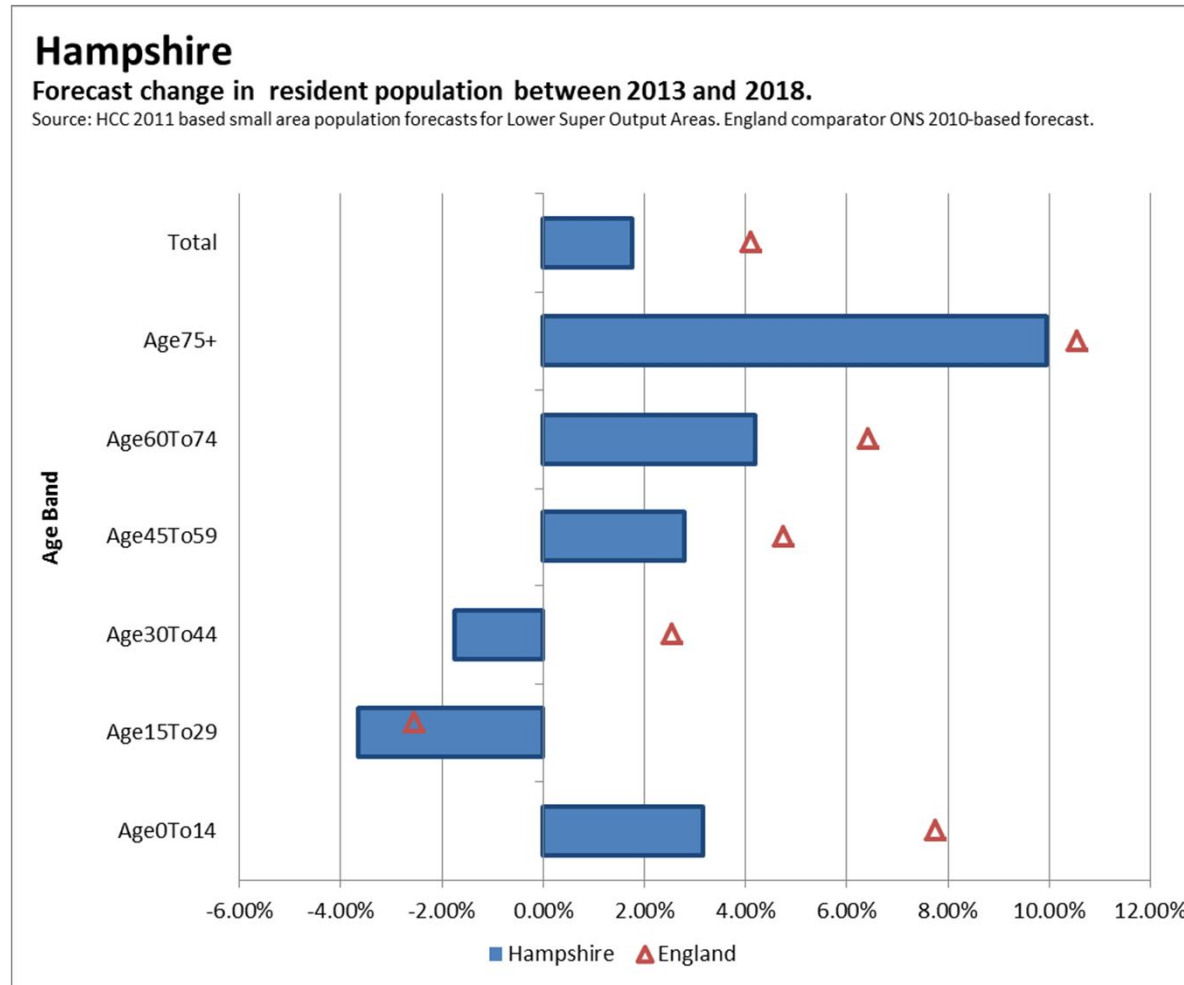

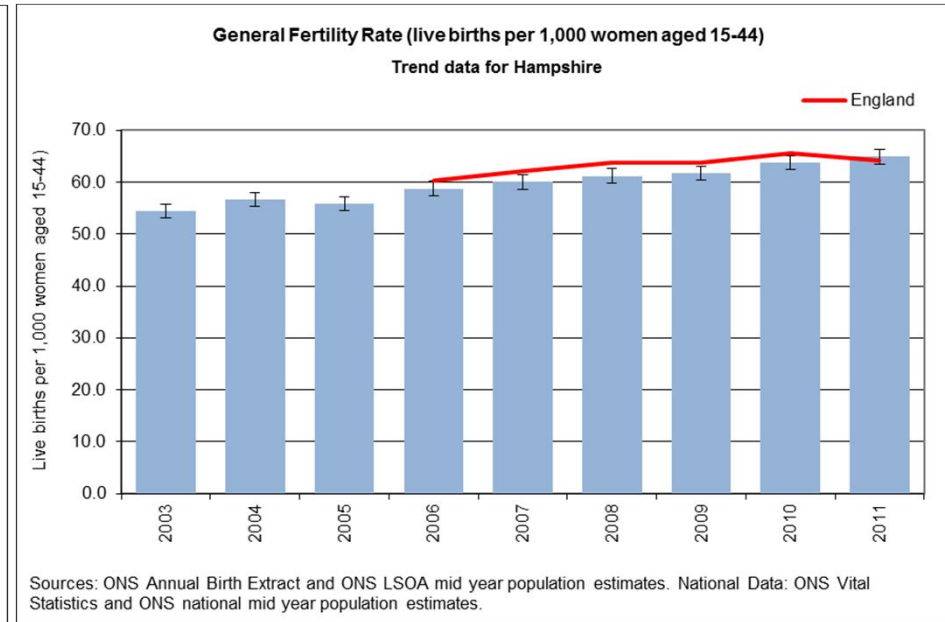
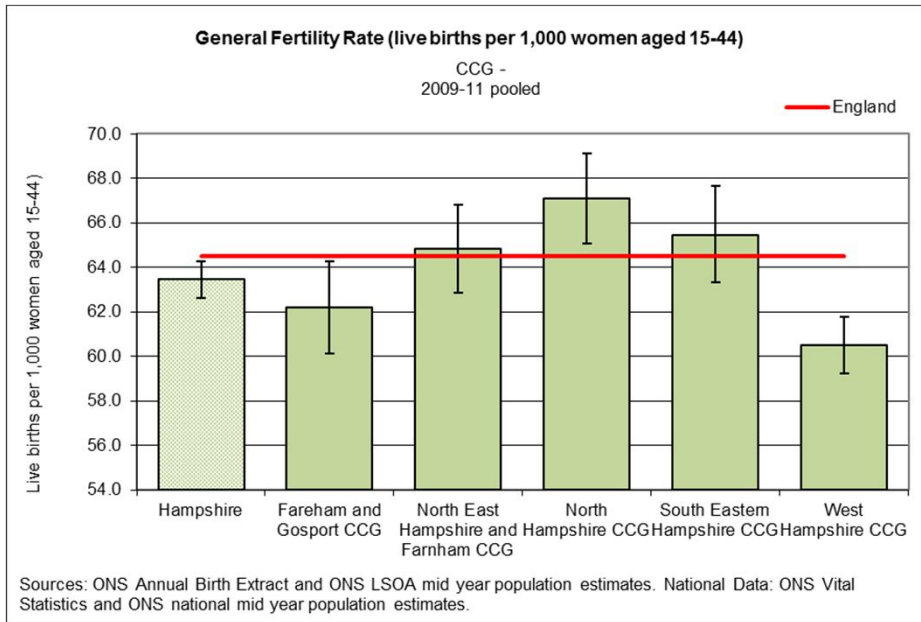
Population



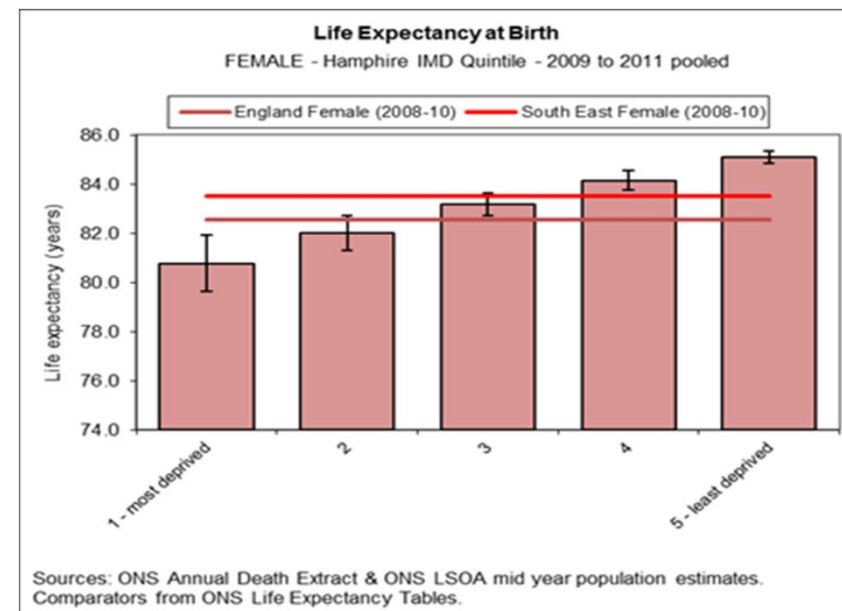
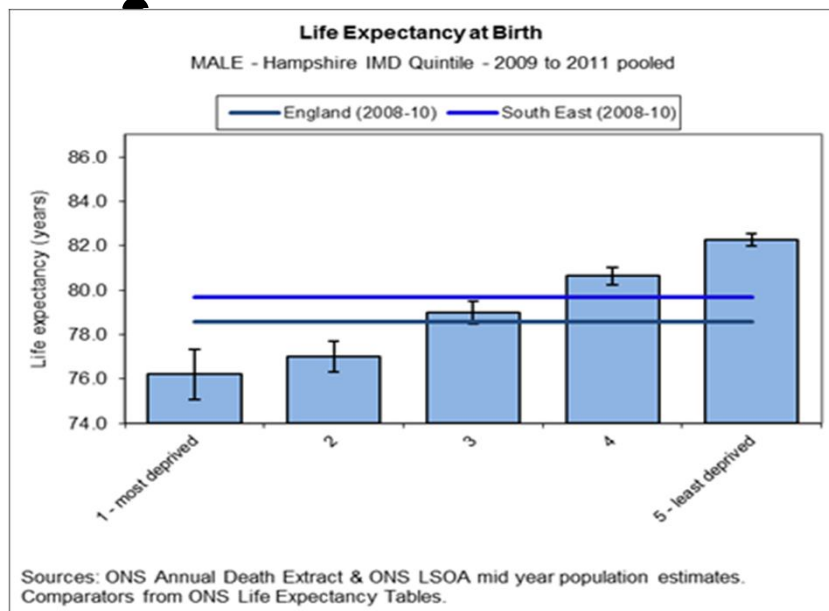
Population projections



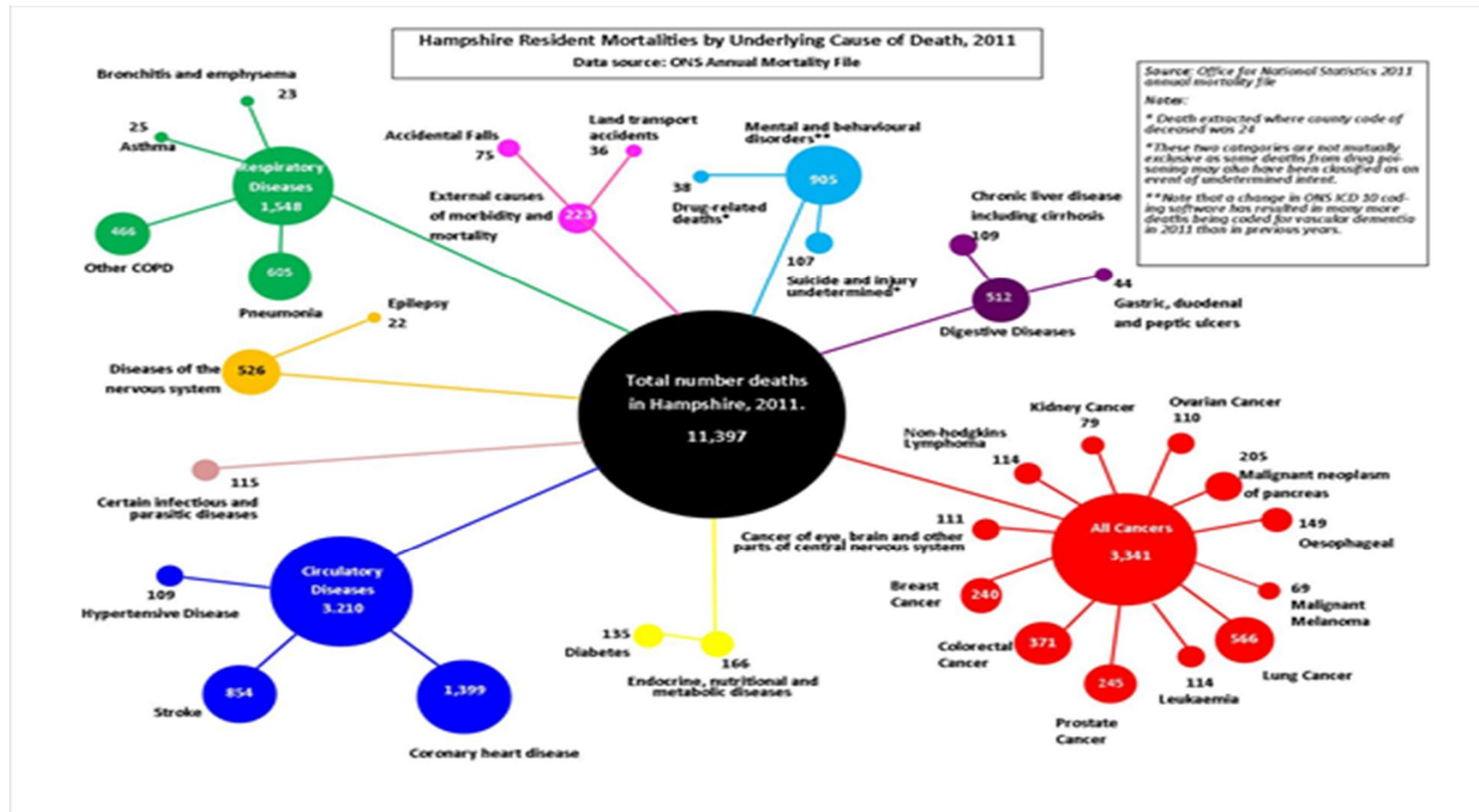
Births

Compared to 14 other similar local authorities for premature deaths per 100,000 (2009-2011)

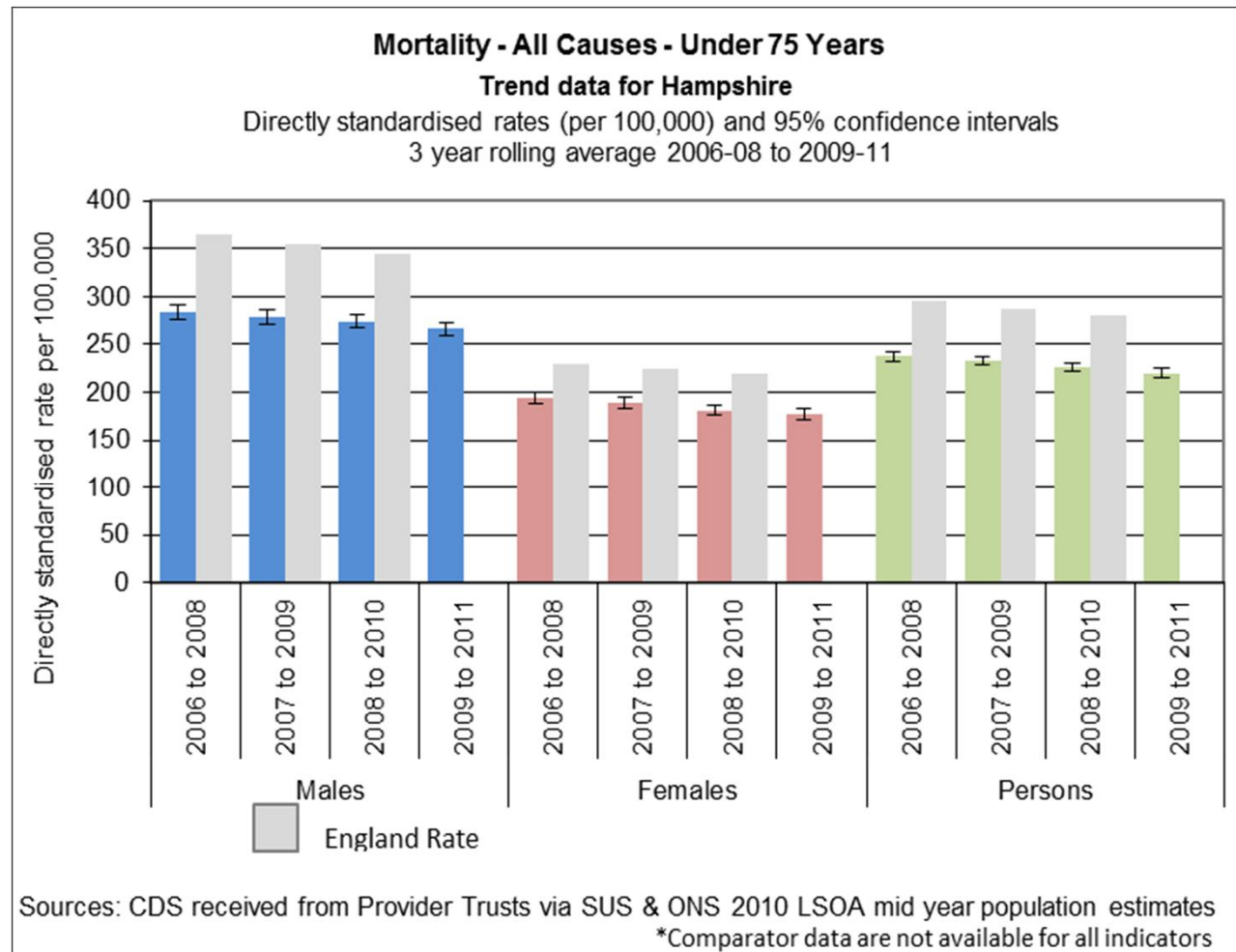
Hampshire ranks

- 6th overall
- 8th – cancers
- 4th – heart disease, stroke & liver disease
- 10th – lung disease

(national rank 10th)



Premature deaths



What's changing

- Population continuing to grow
- Continued rise in birth rate
- Increasing older population living with multiple issues, reflecting their lives – living longer but not living healthy for longer
- Cancer taking over as main cause of death (was CVD)
- Impact of economy & housing

Implications

- Take into account differences in population need across Hampshire
 - Housing, transport, education, healthcare.....
- Access to services - maternity services & family support
- Increase disease prevention to support healthy life expectancy & continue to work towards integrated health & social care
- Be proactive about addressing inequalities

International evidence base

– Prevention

- Immunisation, physical activity, diet

– Interventions

- Revascularisation, drugs – statins, specialisation & workload/experience, travel times v outcomes, audit/benchmarking

– Rehabilitation

- Following interventions

– Support in community

- Mental wellbeing, primary care for inequalities

? Evidence

- Location for service delivery ? Where
- Optimal size of building to deliver services
 - some services dependent on expensive equipment –fixed operating costs
 - Cost base - @600 beds
