### **THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')**

#### **REGULATION 11 - KEY DECISIONS**

Regulation 11 (cases of special urgency) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 10 to be given 5 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 11 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include setting out the reasons why the meeting is urgent and cannot reasonably be delayed.

The Executive Member for Policy and Resources intends to take a key decision on strategic land matters at a meeting on 24 September 2013 at 2.00pm The Castle, Winchester.

The report seeks the approval of the Executive Member for Policy and Resources on several strategic land matters within Hampshire.

The making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred in order to allow the County Council to respond during relevant Local Plan and other consultation processes and to inform relevant Authorities, in a timely manner, of the County Council's position as strategic landholder in relation to strategic landholdings referred to in the report.

The Chairman of the Policy and Resources Select Committee has consented to this decision being taken pursuant to Regulation 11.
