1. Summary

- 1.1 Following the resignation of Jane Warren and Elaine Bellchambers from SACRE it is proposed that Rhiannon Love and Alasdair Richardson are co-opted to SACRE as Higher Education replacements to represent Primary and Secondary RE courses respectively.
- 1.2 Co-opted members are not members of any of the four main groups of SACRE and do not have voting rights. They are, however, able to participate fully in discussions at SACRE meetings.
- 1.3 Following the retirement of the Reverend Ganshin Rock, the Buddhist representative on SACRE, it is proposed that Reverend Seishin Darren Clark, be appointed as his replacement.

2. Recommendation

- 2.1. That SACRE approves the co-option of Rhiannon Love and Alistair Richardson to represent Winchester University Primary and Secondary RE courses respectively, on SACRE.
- 2.2. That SACRE approves the appointment of the Reverend Seishin Darren Clark as the Buddhist representative to SACRE.
