1. Summary

- 1.1. This report summarises the incidents and events in the Harbour from 27 September 2013. Any incidents or events which take place after this report is distributed will be the subject of a separate Annex to be circulated at the meeting.

2. Patrols

- 2.1. The harbour has been patrolled by the Duty Harbour Master at various times between 0800 and 1800 daily.

3. Incidents and events

- 3.1. 5 Oct. A small motor boat sank whilst alongside the Harbour Master's Jetty at Warsash. Wreck mark deployed. Vessel refloated, towed to slipway and taken away by owner.
- 3.2. 6 Oct. Patrol helped to remove a mooring line which had fouled the propeller of a yacht.
- 3.3. 10 Oct. Harbour staff assisted with loading a coffin onto a boat for a burial at sea which took place south of the Isle of Wight.
- 3.4. 13 Oct. Patrol assisted the emergency services in dealing with an injured crew member on board a yacht which berthed alongside at Warsash.
- 3.5. 17 Oct. Patrol recovered a large dog which had become trapped by the ebb tide against an outfall culvert alongside the Bunny Meadows footpath. The dog made a full recovery and the owner was given first aid for superficial cuts and bruises.
- 3.6. 20, 21 and 24 Oct. Patrol attended a number of boats with problems resulting from strong winds.

- 3.7. 27 Oct. Patrol carried out thorough checks on all mid-stream moorings prior to forecast storm force winds.
- 3.8. 28 Oct. Patrol spent most of the day sorting out problems as a result of overnight winds.
