- c) That the applications to the Community Buildings Capital Fund for 2013/14 from the Lee on the Solent Community Association and St Stephens Village Hall application were not supported as the organisations were unable to provide the required information to undertake a full assessment of their

applications in line with the scheme's criteria. The organisations requested their applications be withdrawn from the grant stream.

- d) That in relation to the application for partnership funding from Waltham Chase Village Hall, the decision was taken to defer this application to allow further information to be sought. Once satisfactory details have been received then authority be delegated to the Director of Culture, Communities and Business Services to make a decision on this request.
