### Notice of Key Decision

This notice sets out key decisions which will be made by the County Council's Executive, acting either individually or collectively as a Cabinet or by officers of the County Council.

The County Council has defined a key decision as one which is likely either:

- a. to result in the County Council incurring expenditure, or making savings, which go over £1,000,000 or are less than that but are significant in terms of the County Council's budget for the service or function to which the decision relates; or
- b. to be significant because it is likely to affect communities living or working in two or more electoral divisions in the County Council's administrative area.

Summary of Decision:	The report seeks approval to procure and spend and enter into necessary contractual arrangements to implement the proposed improvements at Leigh Road, Woodside Avenue and Passfield Avenue in Eastleigh, at an estimated cost of £1,000,000, funded from Section 106 developer contributions and Local Transport Plan funding. The scheme consists of two new toucan crossings on the north and west arms of the junction; and widening, to varying degrees, on all arms of the junction.
