1. The decision:

- 1.1. That Hampshire County Council register as an ‘interested party’ in the decision making process in respect of the Navitus Bay Offshore Windfarm.
- 1.2. That a ‘relevant representation’ based on the wording at paragraph 2.14 of the supporting report be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The County Council performs a number of statutory duties which both impact on, and are impacted by, this proposed development and which it is legally obliged to discharge in respect of this proposed offshore windfarm. The County Council also has a number of non-statutory and advisory interests in the development. These interests and duties can be best represented by taking part in the Examination into proposed development.
