- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport, and Environment declares that the land at Leesland Road and Harding Road, Gosport, as indicated in the attached plans, is now surplus to Economy, Transport, and Environment operational requirements.

- 2.1. The properties in question were acquired as advance purchases for the original South Hampshire Rapid Transit light rapid transit scheme. This scheme eventually developed into the Bus Rapid Transit scheme, which has since opened. The properties lie on a section of the originally proposed scheme that is no longer to be progressed.
