- a) That as part of its wider corporate responsibility and commitment to make Hampshire a safe and secure place for residents and visitors, Cabinet welcome and endorse the approach of the County Council to the delivery of adult safeguarding through the Adult Services Department.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The Care Act 2014 will be implemented from April 2015 and will reinforce the role of the Local Authority and formally name the Police and NHS Commissioners as key partner agencies. This Act will place adult safeguarding on a statutory footing, in line with arrangements for Children's safeguarding. It is important that the Cabinet is kept informed of their responsibilities in relation to these changes.


