Incidents and Events

The following incidents and events occurred in the period from 7 to 22 September 2014:

- 1.1 9 Sep. No 2 Cardinal topmark reported damaged in a collision with a yacht. The topmark is bent at a 10 degree angle but has defied efforts to straighten it.
- 1.2 9 Sep. Trinity House Audit of aids to navigation (daymarks and lights). A full report will be provided to the next meeting.
- 1.3 17 Sep. Patrol assisted a yacht which had grounded on Hook Spit. No damage.
- 1.4 19 Sep. Patrol called to assist a lady with a badly injured finger onboard a moored yacht. The casualty was taken ashore where she was met and taken to hospital.
- 1.5 21 Sep. 'Bart's Bash', a world record attempt at the largest ever sailing race took place across the globe. In the Hamble, there was dinghy racing inside the River and yacht and dinghy racing outside the River. An estimated 250 boats took part locally.
