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### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the County Council confirms its approach to securing developer funding to deliver infrastructure to support sustainable economic growth across Hampshire, as set out in section 5 of the report.
- 1.2. That delegated authority is given to the Director of Economy, Transport and Environment, in consultation with the Leader and relevant Executive Members to engage and negotiate via the Hampshire Partnership with the local planning authorities to secure developer funding contributions and to periodically publish technical reports and updates on strategic infrastructure requirements and delivery in Hampshire.
- 1.3. That the position on major developments be noted, and that Cabinet confirms support for active engagement by the County Council in the development of those sites to support high quality and exemplar development and sustainable economic growth.

### 2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. To ensure that the County Council is in a strong position to negotiate with developers and to support district partners on infrastructure and funding requirements, particularly in relation to the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) and other developer funding mechanisms, in order to secure the timely provision of infrastructure to support high quality in developments and sustainable economic growth.

### 3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. A decision could have been taken not to fully engage with local planning authorities but this was rejected as it would have weakened the position of

the County Council and its public sector partners (HFRS, Hampshire Constabulary and the NHS) to negotiate and secure developer funding for infrastructure. .

3.2. A decision could also have been taken to change the approach to developer funding, but this also was rejected as it would have reduced the funds available to support timely provision of infrastructure.


