#### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the feedback from the public consultation and overall positive response to the preferred schemes summarised in this report be noted and that where appropriate comments received are taken on board.
- 1.2. That the preferred schemes as outlined in this report be approved as Council policy, are formally safeguarded and are progressed with immediate effect.
  - **Peel Common Roundabout - 2015/16,**
  - **Stubbington Bypass and associated improvements to Titchfield Road, Gosport Road, and further improvements to Peel Common roundabout - 2017/18** (subject to securing Planning Permission)
  - **Newgate Lane southern section and further improvements to Peel Common roundabout –2017/18;** (subject to securing Planning Permission)
  - **A27 between Titchfield Gyratory and Segensworth roundabout - phased work package** - commencing with the implementation of improvements at: St Margaret's roundabout in 2015/16; followed by improvements to the A27 east from St Margaret's roundabout to Titchfield Gyratory, then west from St Margaret's roundabout to Segensworth roundabout in 2016/17.
- 1.3 That authority be delegated to the Director of Economy, Transport and Environment, in consultation with the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment, to progress work for the preferred schemes listed above, as defined at the public consultation and on the attached plans, and to prepare Full Business Cases and secure funding, to help facilitate early implementation.

## **2. Reasons for the decision:**

- 2.1. To confirm support for the preferred schemes identified to improve access to Fareham and Gosport, and to seek approval to submit planning applications where appropriate, prepare full business cases, and seek funding for the schemes; and
- 2.2. To deliver Peel Common roundabout and parts of the A27 improvements in 2015/16 and 2016/17 subject to funding confirmation.
- 2.3. The delivery of improved access to Fareham and Gosport will help maximise the well being of residents by reducing congestion and delays to key destinations and will enhance the quality of place, particularly in the central area of Stubbington.

## **3. Other options considered and rejected:**

- 3.1. As the majority of respondents to the consultation supported the proposals both in terms of the overarching strategy and the individual component schemes, to not progress the schemes further is not considered an appropriate way forward.
