## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')**

#### **REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS**

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 10 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment intends to take a key decision regarding the allocation of local match funding for major transport schemes which will primarily be funded through Local Growth Deal funds allocated by the Local Enterprise Partnerships (LEPs). The Executive Member decision will be taken at a meeting on 4 November 2014 at 14:00 at: The Castle, Winchester.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment's intention to take this key decision due to the timescales in which the LEP Boards now need to consider and agree the next stages of the transportation funding to submit their proposals to central Government for sign off; the LEP's agreement of funding is contingent on prior approval of local match funding allocations from Hampshire County Council.
