1. The decision:

1.1. That the significant progress in developing the package of transport measures required to support the future delivery of the Whitehill and Bordon major development area is noted and that, taken together, the following documents described in the supporting report are adopted as the current, detailed transport strategy and subject to funding being made available, guide future delivery, and development planning decisions:

- Public Transport Strategy;
- Walking and Cycling Strategy;
- Traffic Management Strategy;
- Parking Strategy;
- Freight Strategy;
- Completion of further work on rail access feasibility;
- A325 Urban Design and Traffic Management Strategy;
- Identification of a Relief Road preferred alignment.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. To provide an up to date and consolidated transport strategy for the Whitehill and Bordon major development area as the basis for developing and implementing a costed programme of transport schemes
- 2.2. To provide a detailed framework for prioritising transport interventions for inclusion in a funded implementation programme.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. An alternative option would be to retain the previously adopted Emerging Transport Strategy (ETS) and subsequent detailed strategies. However, the

ETS was only intended to support the development of the master plan which has now been achieved and it has always been anticipated that the Transport Strategy would be revised to keep it up to date with evolution of the wider development proposals and the more detailed transport appraisals.
