The decision:

- a) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Public Health give approval to go out to tender and seek authorisation to spend for the Public Health 'Healthy Lifestyle' procurement category with a combined total value of up to £24,380,000 (3 years plus extensions of up to 2 years giving a total maximum contract term of 5 years)
 - NHS Health Checks - £7,035,000
 - Tobacco Control Services £15,655,000
 - Health Trainers Services £825,000
 - Weight Management - £865,000
- b) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Public Health give approval to waive Contract Standing Order 5.7 and approve the establishment of an Approved List of qualified providers to procure NHS Health Checks and Sexual Health Level 2 services for a term of up to 5 years on the basis of initial term of 3 years with an option to extend for up to a further 2 years (3+1+1).
- c) That it is noted that in relation to b) above, Sexual Health Level 2 services are; Long Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC), Emergency Hormonal Contraception, Chlamydia screening, testing kits and condom distribution.
- d) That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care and Public Health give approval be given to waive the requirement to seek references under Contract Standing Order 5.9d.

2. Reason(s) for the decision:

- 2.1. This report supports the implementation of the Public Health Strategic Procurement Plan which was given Executive Member approval on 20 September 2013 (Report, referenced 5128).
- 2.2. The Healthy Lifestyle category of the above procurement plan detailed in section 3 of this report includes the commissioning of key public health services for the Hampshire population.
- 2.3. A review of the procurement timeline for the Healthy Lifestyles services has been necessary and it is proposed to put in place new contracts by way of procurement processes by 1 April 2016 for NHS Health Checks and 1 October 2016 for Tobacco Control, Weight Management and Health Trainers services.
- 2.4. An open or Restricted procurement process will be used in line with HCC best practice for Tobacco Control, Weight Management and Health Trainers services.
- 2.5. Approval is sought to use an alternative procurement process (Approved List) for NHS Health Checks.
- 2.6. Sexual Health Level 2 services are not part of the Healthy Lifestyle category and tender and spend approvals have already been granted (Report reference: 5128). These services are included here because approval is sought to use the same procurement process applying the same waivers to Contract Standing Orders as NHS Health Checks.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. A review of each service was undertaken as part of the planned implementation of the Public Health Strategic Procurement Plan and informed the phased re-procurement of these key public health services.
- 3.2. The reasons for recommending the establishment of Approved Lists of qualified providers for NHS Health Checks and Sexual Health Level 2 services is set out in section 4 of this report and is considered appropriate given the nature of the services, market, strategic procurement plan and the way in which the Approved Lists would be managed.
