**1. The decision:**

That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment:

- 1.1. Approves for consultation, the draft Minerals and Waste Safeguarding Supplementary Planning Document and associated documentation.
- 1.2. Approves for consultation, the draft Oil and Gas Development in Hampshire Supplementary Planning Document and associated documentation.
- 1.3. Approves that formal public consultation on the two Supplementary Planning Documents will take place at the same time, for a minimum of 6 weeks in line with the provisions of the Hampshire Statement of Community Involvement (SCI), during summer 2015.

**2. Reasons for the decision:**

- 2.1. The Hampshire Minerals and Waste Plan (HMWP) was adopted in October 2013. The issue of the effective implementation of the HMWP on minerals and waste safeguarding when other non minerals and waste developments are proposed has emerged as an issue for the County Council. In addition, the increase in interest from Hampshire's local communities and interested parties has also emerged as an issue.
- 2.2. Executive Member approval is sought to undertake formal public consultation on draft Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) on these issues.

**3. Other options considered and rejected:**

3.1. Further guidance on the implementation of the HMWP policies will ensure that minerals and waste safeguarding issues are considered appropriately and that the council is prepared for the submission of any proposals for oil and gas development. As the SPDs will facilitate the effective implementation of the HMWP, no other options were considered.
