

PUBLIC NOTICE**THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')****REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS**

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 10 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Executive Member for Adult Social Care intends to take three key decisions; regarding:

- planned changes to the Supporting People Social Inclusion Services, and tender for new services that focus resources on those with the highest needs, supporting prevention and early intervention;
- the allocation of additional funding awarded by the Clinical Commissioning Groups to support service delivery of the dementia advisor service in Hampshire;
- an extension to the Single Tender approval for externally contracted Day Services for Older People

at a meeting on 24 June 2015 at 13:00 at: The Castle, Winchester.

The intention to take these decisions was previously notified, and due to recent changes in Executive Member responsibilities, they are being re-notified to confirm that the decision maker will be the Executive Member for Adult Social Care. It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Executive Member for Adult Social Care's intention to take these key decisions due to the timing of the recent portfolio changes.
