**1. The decision:**

1.1 That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment declares that the land as indicated in Appendices 1 to 4:

- adjoining The Old Chapel, Main Road, Tadley;
- at Newtown Primary School, Gosport (St Vincent’s College Playing Fields);
- adjoining Brune Park School, Military Road, Gosport; and
- at 37 Salisbury Road, Totton

is now surplus to Economy, Transport and Environment operational requirements.

**2. Reason for the decision:**

2.1 For various historical reasons outlined in the supporting report, the County Council holds these areas of land for highways purposes. Changing priorities have now determined that these lands are no longer required, and have become a maintenance liability.

**3. Other options considered and rejected:**

3.1 Retention of the lands. This option was rejected on the grounds that they are no longer needed, that they represent a maintenance liability, and that this would preclude generating income through their disposal. For Newtown

Primary School, Brune Park School and Salisbury Road, the decision will also benefit other County Council departments.
