184. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Mark Cooper and Keith House.

185. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

Members were mindful that where they believed they had a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest in any matter considered at the meeting they must declare that interest at the time of the relevant debate and, having regard to the circumstances described in Part 3 Paragraph 1.5 of the County Council's Members' Code of Conduct, leave the meeting while the matter was discussed, save for exercising any right to speak in accordance with Paragraph 1.6 of the Code. Furthermore Members were mindful that where they believed they had a Non-Pecuniary Interest in a matter being considered at the meeting they considered whether such interest should be declared, and having regard to Part 5, Paragraph 2 of the Code, considered whether it was appropriate to leave the meeting whilst the matter was discussed, save for exercising any right to speak in accordance with the Code.

189. APPLICATION FOR A DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER TO RECORD PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BETWEEN KING'S FARM AND ARNEWOOD DRIVE, HORDLE

The Committee considered a report of the Director of Culture, Communities and Business Services (Item 6 in the Minute Book) seeking approval to record public footpaths over land at King's Farm and Arnewood Drive in Hordle.

The Director summarised the main points within the report and advised Members that based on evidence received, the amount of use by the public during the relevant period of 1985-2005 was insufficient for the claimed routes to be recorded as public rights of way under Section 31 of the Highways Act 1980.

RESOLVED:

That the application for a Definitive Map Modification Order to record public footpaths between King's Farm and Arnewood Drive in Hordle be refused.

190. APPLICATION FOR A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER FOR PART OF SWANMORE FOOTPATH NO 10

Councillor Huxstep declared an interest in this item as he is the local member. He took no part in the discussion and left the meeting at this point.

The Committee considered a report of the Director of Culture Communities and Business Services (Item 7 in the Minute Book) seeking approval to divert part of Swanmore Footpath No.10.)

The Committee were advised that this application had been received to correct an anomaly on the definitive map, which had been created by a mapping error associated with a previous diversion, and that the proposed diversion would provide public benefits by offering attractive distant views to the east.

RESOLVED

That an Order be made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 to divert part of Swanmore Footpath No.10, as shown on the accompanying plan to the report.
