160. PROVISION OF SCHOOL PLACES

1. On the 3 June 2015, the Executive Member for Education took a number of decisions to approve the expansion of seven schools around Hampshire, in order to increase the provision of school places in those areas and meet the needs of the communities. The total approved spend for these works is £21,440,000, arising from the Children's Services Capital Programme, which was agreed by the Executive Lead Member for Children's Service on 21 January 2015.

2. The schools for which approval was given are (number of increased places shown in brackets):

- Great Binfields Primary School, Basingstoke (210)
- Hook Infant and Junior Schools (150)
- Marnel Community Infant and Junior Schools, Basingstoke (210)
- Tower Hill Primary School, Farnborough (210)
- Oakwood Infant School, Hartley Wintney (90)
- Greenfields Junior School, Hartley Wintney (120)
- Brookfield Community School, Sarisbury Green (45)

3. In each case, an individual project appraisal was considered, setting out the local requirements, which may include the expansion of facilities such as kitchen areas as well as classrooms.
