

## **Project Description**

It is the intention of the Royal Air Force Yacht Club to install a single pontoon between piles F59-62. This is to enhance the safety of mooring holders. Currently no pontoons exist in this location but do exist on similar pile moorings elsewhere in the river.

The new pontoon will be 34.5 metres long and 2 metres wide and secured to the piles centrally this will not allow for any side way movement of vessels as is the current situation. No piling works form part of this application although it is understood that the Crown estates will be replacing piles along this stretch of river during the winter of 2015/6. This will enhance the safety and predictability of navigation.

This proposal has been granted planning permission by Eastleigh Borough council ref F/15/76560

The number of moorings will remain the same (max 6) although larger vessels will be facilitated.

A full method statement from our suppliers Walcon marine has been supplied.

It is hoped that all work will take place from November 2015 for the piling with pontoons in place for 1st April 2016
